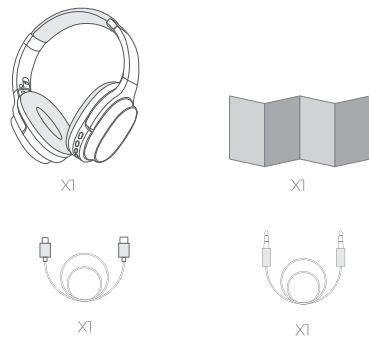

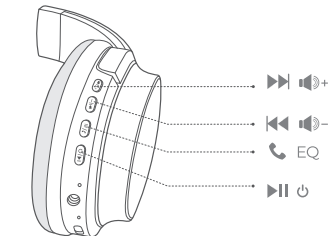

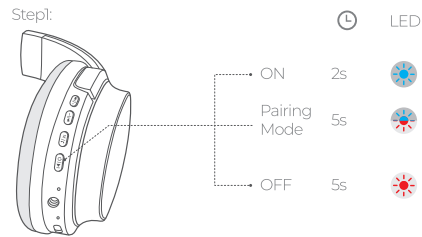

How to Pair

- DE Pairing-Modus

Press and hold it for 5s until the red and blue indicator lights flash alternately in power off mode. Turn on the Bluetooth of your device, and find "BLTD385" in the list to connect.

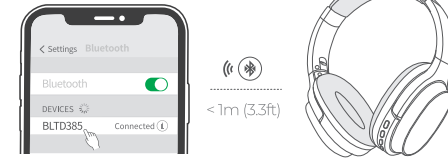
Bei ausgeschaltetem Zustand drücken Sie den Knopf 5 Sekunden, bis rote und blaue Licht abwechselnd blinkt. Schalten Sie das Bluetooth des Geräts ein und dann suchen Sie "BLTD385" in der Liste zu verbinden.

Appuyez longuement sur cette touche pendant 5s pour passer en mode de couplage pendant l'arrêt. Pendant ce temps, les voyants rouge et bleu dignotent alternativement. Allumez le Bluetooth du téléphone mobile, recherchez l'appareil Bluetooth et trouvez "BLTD385" dans la liste pour le connecter.

Manténgalo pulsado durante 5s para ingresar al modo de sincronización durante el apagado. Mientras tanto, las luces indicadoras rojas y azules parpadean alternativamente. Encienda el Bluetooth del teléfono móvil, busque el dispositivo Bluetooth y busque "BLTD385" en la lista para conectarlo.

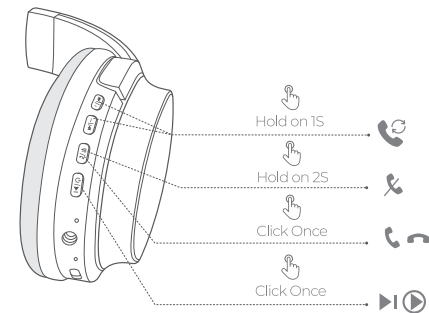

Charge the Headphones



FAQ

1. Cannot turn on headphones

- Make sure the headphones are full charged.
- Make sure the headphones are off while charging. Please disconnect the Type-C charging cable before you turn on the headphones.

2. Cannot charge headphones

- Please use the provided Micro USB charging cable.
- Make sure the USB charging cable is connected firmly to your headphones, Micro USB adapters and computers.
- Make sure the Micro USB adapters are connected firmly to your power outlets.

3. No Sound from the headphones

- Make sure headphones and paired devices are turned on.
- Make sure headphones and Wireless receiving devices are connected to A2DP via Bluetooth.
- Please turn up the volume when the volume is too low.
- Make sure the paired devices are in normal operation.
- Make sure the audio output device on your PC is the Bluetooth® device when you connect headphones to computers.
- Make sure the Aux cable is connected firmly in wired mode.

FCC Statement
