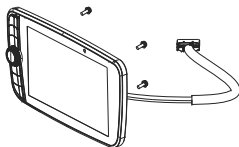
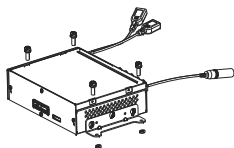

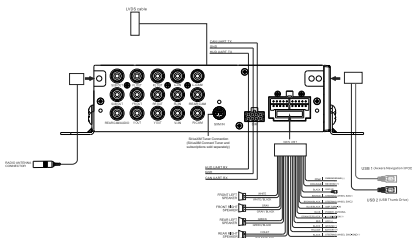


Installation of Front Panel and Control Box

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Wiring Diagram - Inputs/Outputs



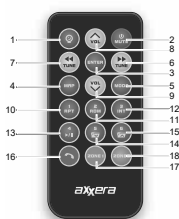

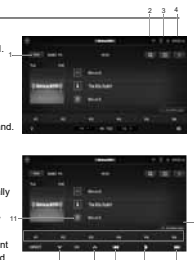
Select the Radio icon from the Main Menu screen or press MODE until Tuner is selected.

SiriusXM® Operation

1. **Band**
Displays SiriusXM® radio band currently selected. Third bands are available: SXM1, SXM2, and SXM3.
2. **Search**
Press this icon to search channels by category
3. **Channel List**
Press this icon to see the preset channels per band
4. **Function**
Press this icon to list mode/Tune Scan/ Go to Live channels.
5. **Channel Down**
Press this icon to select station backward manually
6. **Channel Up**
Press this icon to select station forward manually
7. **Skip Backward**
Tap this icon to skip to the beginning of the current song or prior songs. Press and hold to fast-rewind.
8. **Pause**
Press this icon to pause the audio.
9. **Skip forward**
Tap this icon to skip to the beginning of the current song or prior songs. Press and hold to fast-rewind.
10. **Presets**
Press and hold to add the current channel to a preset. Tap to recall the preset. a total of 18 presets can be stored, 6 per band.
11. **Content Info**
Press Song icon to cycle through song, content info and description field.



General Operation

Press the function icons to select in Settings



Sound Effect Operation

Press Sound Effect icon in setup menu to select Preset, 10-band tone control, and Balance.

Speaker Zone Operation

Zone 1 Button Press Zone 1 to turn the sound from Zone 1 on or off.

Bluetooth Operation

Bluetooth Microphone
The microphone is built in the receiver

Pairing and Connecting
Make sure that Bluetooth is activated on your device before you begin the pairing process. The unit broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "ASC419N". The unit can be in any mode of operation when pairing is performed. On certain phones, pairing may need to be done more than once.

Dialing a Number
Press to display keypad and dial a number.

Making and Ending a Call
Press to make a phone call , and press to end a call.

Checking Recent Call
Press to check the recent call.

Browsing Phone Book
Press to browse the phone book.

Bluetooth Pairing
Press to pair bluetooth device.

Streaming Audio
Press to play or pause the music.
Press go back to the previous track.
Press to advance to the next track.
