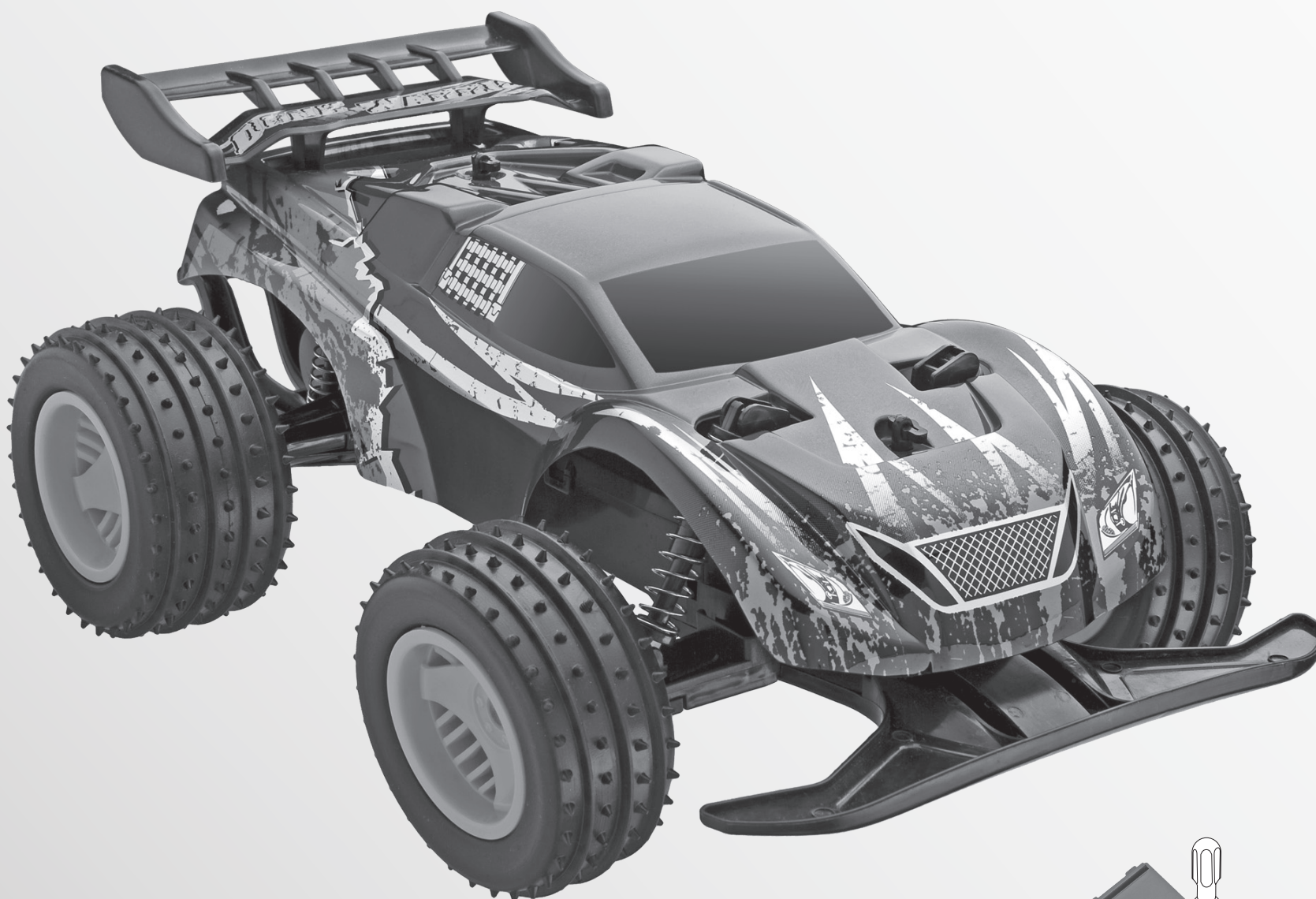

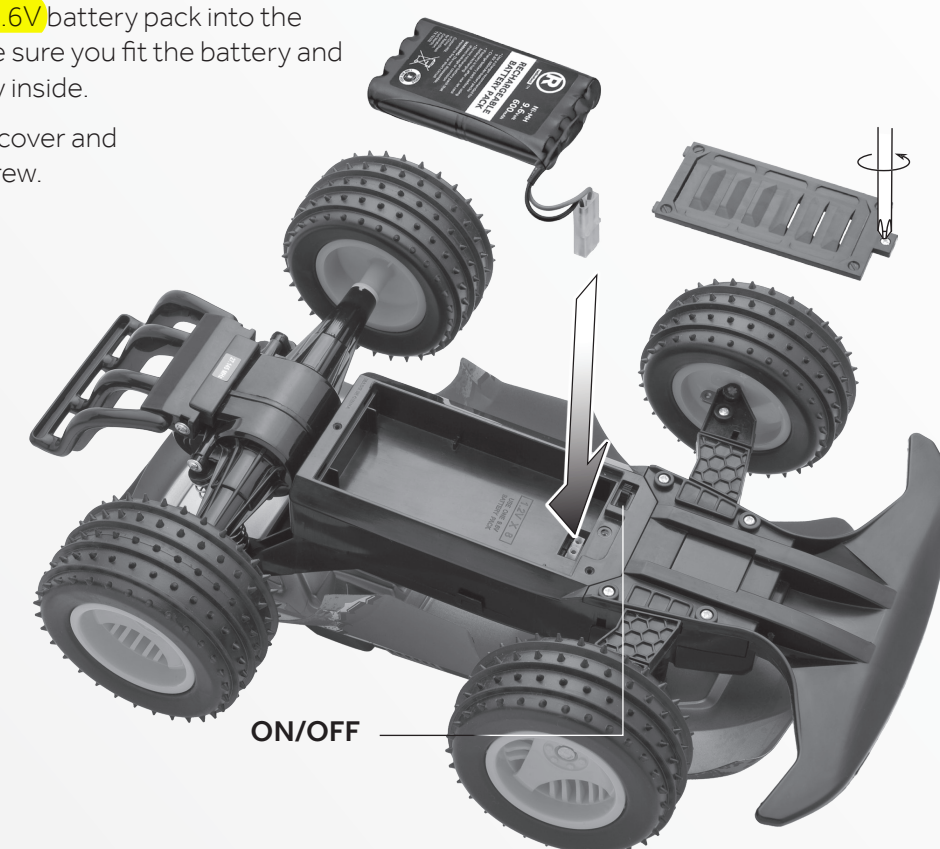

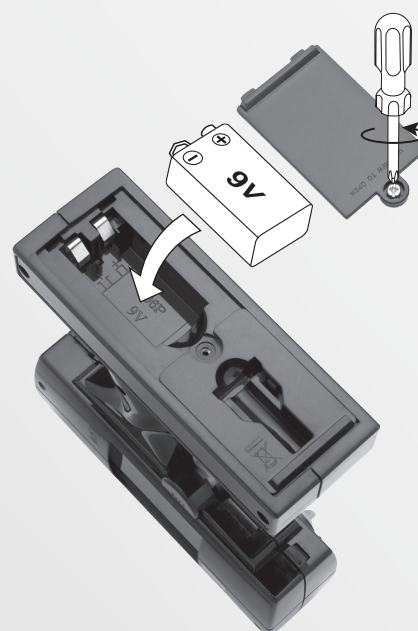
Install Battery Pack in the Vehicle

1. Turn off the vehicle.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery cover, then plug the jack of the 9.6V battery pack into the battery socket. Make sure you fit the battery and battery cables neatly inside.
3. Replace the battery cover and secure it with the screw.



Install Battery in the Transmitter

1. Turn off the transmitter.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert one 9V battery (not included), matching the polarity symbols (+ and -) marked inside the battery compartment. Replace the battery cover and secure it with the screw.



Pairing Your Vehicle and the Transmitter

Your vehicle operates at a frequency of 2.4Ghz. Before driving the first time, you must pair the transmitter and vehicle.

1. Place the transmitter and the vehicle close to each other within 3 feet (1m).
2. Turn on the transmitter and the vehicle. The LED on the transmitter flashes quickly, and then lights green after 30 seconds when transmitter and the vehicle are paired automatically.

Note:

- If the pairing failed, turn off the controller and the vehicle, move closer, and then try again.
- If playing with more than one DP Dune Warrior at the same time, pair each vehicle one by one.

Drive Your Vehicle

Steering

Turn right and left; release to drive straight.

LED

Off - Power off/dead or no battery
On - Paired
Flash quickly - Searching vehicle to pair
Flash slowly - Pairing failed

Steering Trim

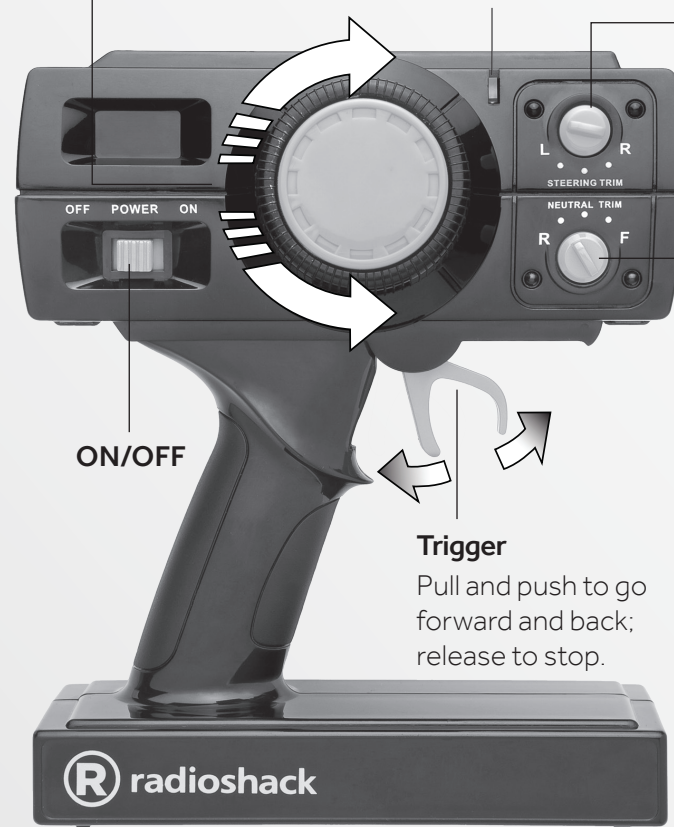
If your vehicle pulls to the left, turn this switch toward **R**; if the vehicle pulls to the right, turn this switch toward **L**.

Neutral Trim

If your vehicle moves backward when it stops, turn this switch toward **F**; if the vehicle moves forward, turn this switch toward **R**.

Trigger

Pull and push to go forward and back; release to stop.



Charge the Vehicle Battery Pack

1. Insert the charger's connector securely into the battery pack's connector.
2. Plug the battery charger into a standard AC outlet.
3. Allow 2 hours for each charge. The charging indicator flashes during charging. It stops flashing and remains lit when charging is complete.
4. Unplug the charger and separate the battery connectors when fully charged. When fully charged, the vehicle can run about 18 minutes.

Caution:

- To avoid damage and personal injury, use only the supplied charger to charge the battery pack.
- After playing, wait at least 20 minutes to let the battery pack cool before charging it.

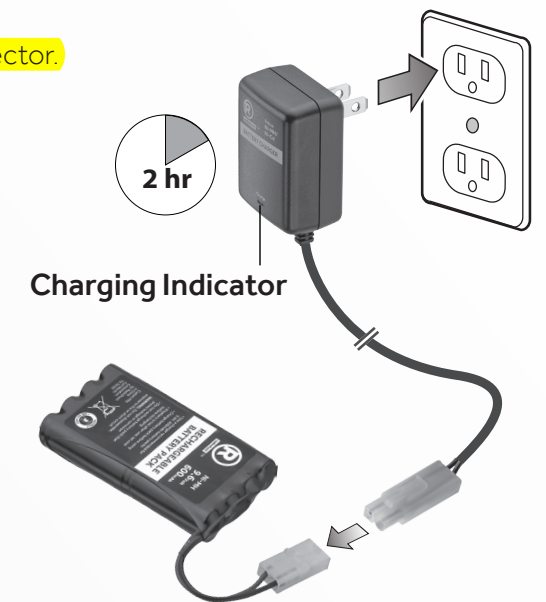
Battery Notes:

- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type. Dispose of the old batteries promptly and properly. Do not burn or bury them.
- Do not disassemble the charger and battery pack. Incorrect assembly can result in risk of electric shock or fire.
- If you do not plan to use the vehicle for a week or longer, remove the batteries from the transmitter and the vehicle.
- Batteries should NEVER be left unattended while charging. Only adults should charge the batteries. Use caution when using the charger to avoid electric shock.
