TURNING ON/PAIRING:

1. Press the **POWER/PLAY/PAUSE** button for 5-6 seconds the LED light will quickly flash four times continue to hold the **POWER** button until the LED light flashes **BLUE & RED**
2. The flashing **BLUE & RED** indicates being in pairing mode. Make sure the audio device or the smartphone's **BLUETOOTH** is turned ON. The device should start searching for **BLUETOOTH** enabled devices. Once the **IPWARBT1** is found click on it or select pair. If there is a password required enter 000 0



TAKING CALLS

1. Press the **POWER/PLAY/PAUSE** button to Answer the call. To end the call press the power button again.
2. To Reject an incoming call Press and Hold **POWER/PLAY/PAUSE** button

VOLUME CONTROL:

1. To adjust the volume, press the Volume +, or Volume - repeatedly to adjust the volume.



POWER/CHARGING:
