After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Regarding the labeling requirements of 15.19, please note that the FCC has given us guidelines stating that devices which are larger than the palm of your hand should have the statements placed on the device. Additionally the current label size and available surface seem to allow sufficient room to include the labeling statements. However, if you have examples from previous submittals that show that the FCC allowed this to be placed in the users manual, we can use this as a precedence to allow it for this submittal? If not, we can ask the FCC for an interpretation regarding this issue, but please note that this may take a while do to the holidays and the fact that the FCC will be busy handling their backlog. Please let us know how you wish to proceed with this issue.
- 2) We have had recent feedback from the FCC regarding these types of devices and how to test them for multiple enclosures. They have stated that each type of configuration must at least be evaluated (pretested, etc) to ensure the worse case configuration is being tested. You have expressed interest in allowing all 4 lid types with plastic and concrete pits, as long as they are mechanically identical to those shown in the users manual. Therefore for this application:
 - a) Please update the test report to list all combinations and explain how the various lids were evaluated/pretested, etc.
 - b) Please update the users manual to show all allowable combinations as you have mentioned in your last response. Also, please clearly indicate that only the combinations shown are allowed to be used.

NOTE: The burden of proof for compliance will continue to be that of the manufactures. Therefore any aspect of the device that affects compliance (type of pit/modification/etc.) must be clearly presented to the installers to ensure the device is properly installed.

FYI.....Grant Conditions:

This device is only authorized for use in water pit installations in the ground using metallic, concrete, or plastic enclosures as specified in the application. Installations in concrete or plastic enclosures may use the various lid combinations only as specified in the application. Installations in concrete or plastic enclosure must include an additional foil as specified within the application.

Failure to provide the requested information may result in application termination.
