

4.1.3 TEST PROCEDURES


- a. The EUT was placed 0.4 meters from the conducting wall of the shielded room with EUT being connected to the power mains through a line impedance stabilization network (LISN). Other support units were connected to the power mains through another LISN. The two LISNs provide 50 ohm/ 50uH of coupling impedance for the measuring instrument.
- b. Both lines of the power mains connected to the EUT were checked for maximum conducted interference.
- c. The frequency range from 150kHz to 30MHz was searched. Emission levels over 10dB under the prescribed limits could not be reported

- f. Repeat steps b-f.



4.2 RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

4.2.1 LIMITS OF RADIATED EMISSION MEASUREMENT

Emissions radiated outside of the specified bands, shall be according to the general radiated limits in 15.209 as following:

4.2.3 TEST PROCEDURES

- a. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 10 meter open area test site. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower.
- c. The antenna is a broadband antenna, and its height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then the antenna was tuned to heights from 1 meter to 4 meters and the rotatable table was turned from 0 degrees to 360 degrees to find the maximum reading.
- e. The test-receiver system was set to Peak Detect Function and Specified Bandwidth with Maximum Hold Mode.
- f. If the emission level of the EUT in peak mode was 10 dB lower than the limit specified, then testing could be stopped and the peak values of the EUT would be reported. Otherwise the emissions that did not have 10 dB margin would be re-tested one by one using peak, quasi-peak or average method as specified and then reported in a data sheet.

NOTE:

- 1. The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 120kHz for Peak detection (PK) and Quasi-peak detection (QP) at frequency below 1GHz.
- 2. The resolution bandwidth and video bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz for Peak detection at frequency above 1GHz.
- 3. The resolution bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz and the video bandwidth is 10Hz for Average detection (AV) at frequency above 1GHz.

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
















4.6 BAND EDGES MEASUREMENT

4.6.1 LIMITS OF BAND EDGES MEASUREMENT

Below –20dB of the highest emission level of operating band (in 100KHz Resolution Bandwidth).

NOTE: The calibration interval of the above test instruments is 12 months and the calibrations are traceable to NML/ROC and NIST/USA.

4.6.3 TEST PROCEDURE

The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer via a low lose cable. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 1MHz and 300Hz with suitable frequency span including 100MHz bandwidth from band edge. The band edges was measured and recorded.


4.6.6 TEST RESULTS(For CCK)

The spectrum plots are attached on the following 2 pages. D2 line indicates the highest level, D1 line indicates the 20dB offset below D2. It shows compliance with the requirement in part 15.247(C).


NOTE1: The band edge emission plot of CCK technique on the following page shows 52.21 dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3386 GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 (Page 25) is 101.80 dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 101.80 - 52.21 = 49.59 dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

NOTE2: The band edge emission plot of CCK on the following page shows 52.49dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2. 4890GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 (Page 27) is 102.10dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 102.10 –52.49 = 49.61dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

The spectrum plots are attached on the following 2 pages. D2 line indicates the highest level, D1 line indicates the 20dB offset below D2. It shows compliance with the requirement in part 15.247(C).


The band edge emission plot on the following first pages shows 46.29dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.3898GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 (Page 28) is 98.10dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 98.10-46.29=51.81dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.


The band edge emission plot on the following second pages shows 45.19dB delta between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.4836GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.9 (Page 30) is 96.60dBuV/m, so the maximum field strength in restrict band is 96.60-53.05=51.41dBuV/m which is under 54 dBuV/m limit.

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4.7 ANTENNA REQUIREMENT

4.7.1 STANDARD APPLICABLE

For intentional device, according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device.

And according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.247 (b), if transmitting antennas of directional gain greater than 6dBi are used, the power shall be reduced by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.


4.7.2 ANTENNA CONNECTED CONSTRUCTION
