2.2 MPE Calculation Method

The MPE was calculated at 183 cm to show compliance with the power density limit.

The following formula was used to calculate the Power Density:

E (V/m) =

 Power Density: Pd (W/m²) = $\frac{E^2}{377}$

E = Electric field (V/m)

P = RF output power (W)

G = EUT Antenna numeric gain (numeric)

d = Separation distance between radiator and human body (m)
