1. Ensure the product is fully charge/battery use.
2. Some products must installation station at the end of the pathway, please remove them before use.
3. The product only supports charging with a USB cable. It doesn't support to using another cable. (Recommendation power: 3.7V/300)
4. Please confirm the not working properly, disconnected and reconnected. Repeat more than methods are changed and that take them out of the charging case to be work.
