 - a. How does this device operate?
 - b. Provide information on the device and its antenna.
 - c. How is it installed?
 - d. What test procedure was used?
 - e. If tested in a car, how was it configured/tested?
 - f. Was the tuning range properly verified? The test lab should indicate in the report that the tuning controls were manually adjusted to verify maximum tuning range.
 - g. Was the bandwidth properly tested with maximum audio input?.
