This is further to your abovenoted correspondence and conversation with our Chief Technician, Doug Noble clarifying your request. In reply:

1. We agree..MPE measurement data should not have been identical to those submitted previously. Someone here 'goofed'. The proper data is attached and is based on repeat of test.
2. The latest MPE Test Data are for satisfying occupational/controlled exposure requirements and should apply to repeaters configured as base stations. (Please see, for example, the Applicant's FCC ID: ALH31112110 Grant Date 02/21/2001.)

The Instructions to Users and Installers has already been sent to you showing the minimum safe separation distance as 60cm.

We believe the attached and foregoing now completes your requirements and that the Applicant will be issued the Grant A.S.A.P.
