Request for Limited Modular Approval

The modular transmitter (Model: UGEA3A) is designed by Alps Electric Co., Ltd..

The modular transmitter complies with the module basic requirements (Items 1 to 8) in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 "Part 15" Unlicensed Modular Transmitter Approval" as indicated below:
