

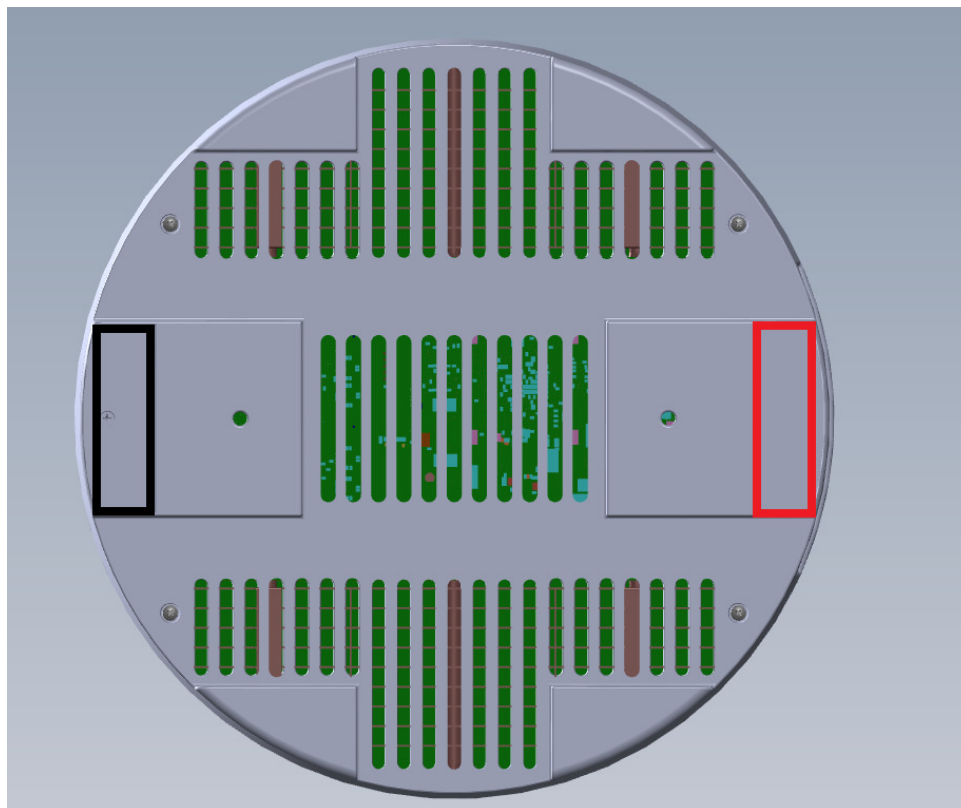
There are four labels on Chevy. All four are printed on 2.75" x 0.75" Zebra Z-Ultimate 2000T labels.

The first two labels are shown below.

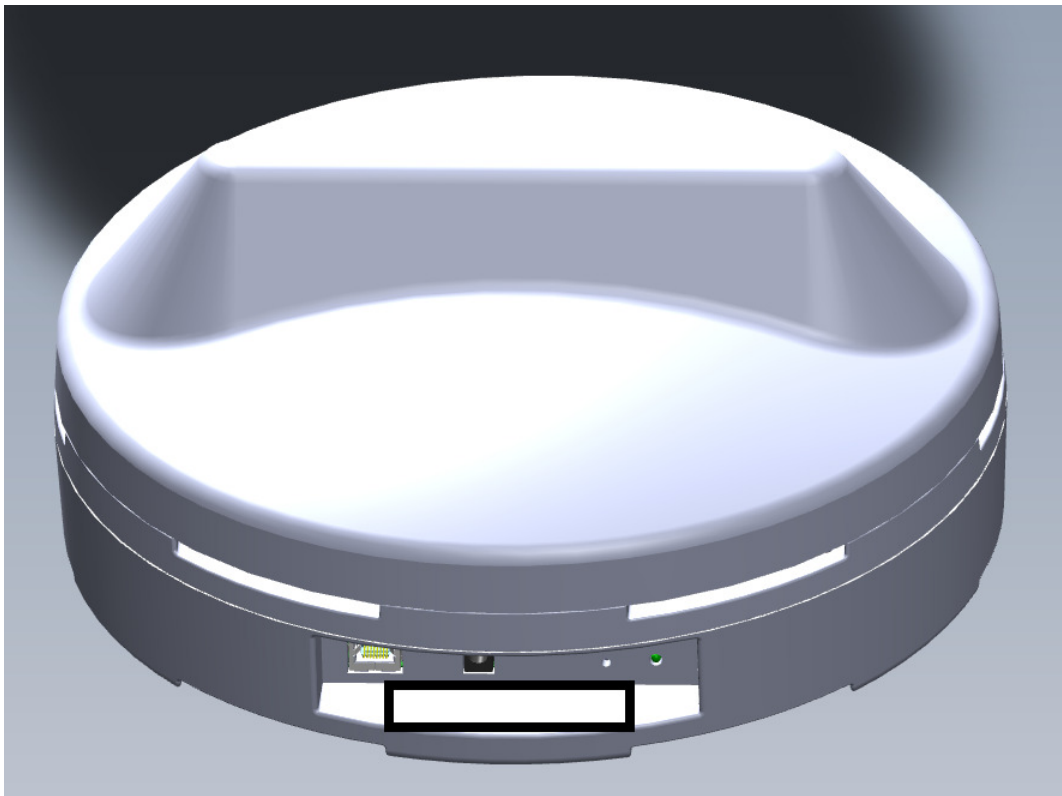
These two labels are located on the bottom of the enclosure as shown in the picture below. The serial number label will be installed where the red rectangle is shown.
