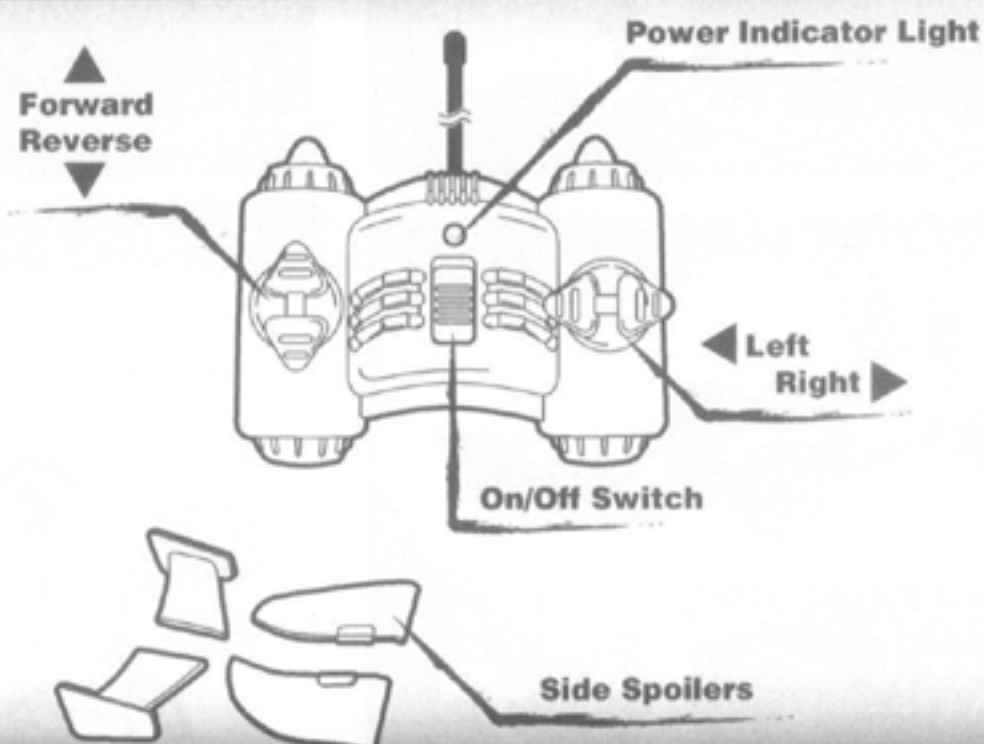
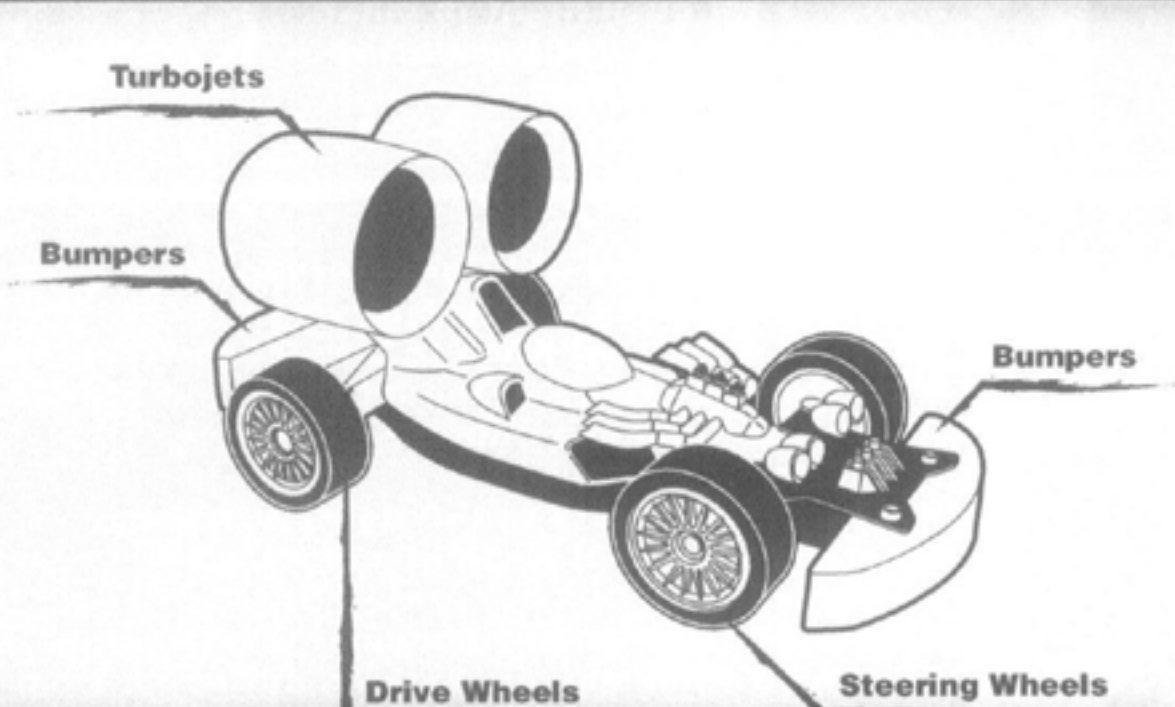


- Vehicle: 1 x "9.6V" Recommended 1200mAh to 2000mAh rechargeable battery (Battery not included)
- Controller: 1 x 9V 6LR61 Battery (Battery not included)

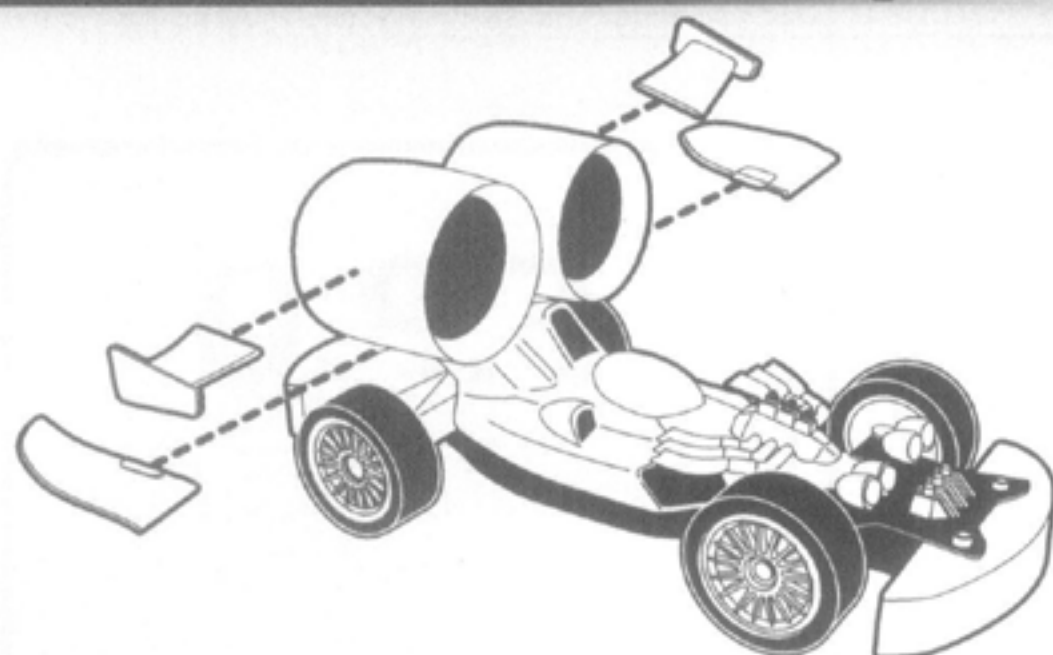
ASSEMBLY

Before you begin to play, screw-in the transmitter antenna about 3 inches into the transmitter. For further details see Battery and Power ON/OFF Diagram.

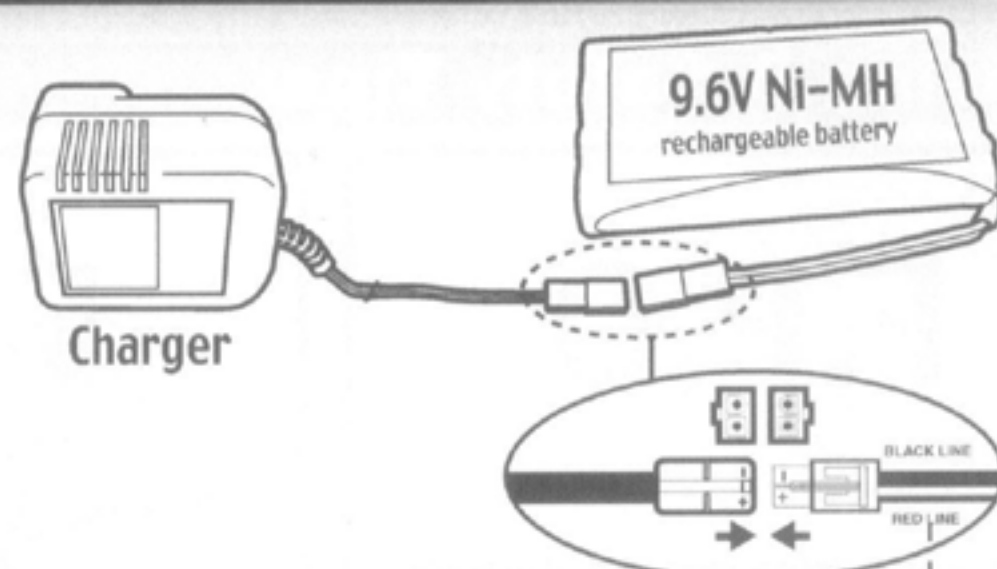


Assembling the Side Spoilers



Carefully unpack the spoilers from the packaging and attach to the side of the turbojets as shown in the diagram. Make sure that you attach the right spoiler to the right side, see diagram for details. Please do not use excessive force.

Battery Charging



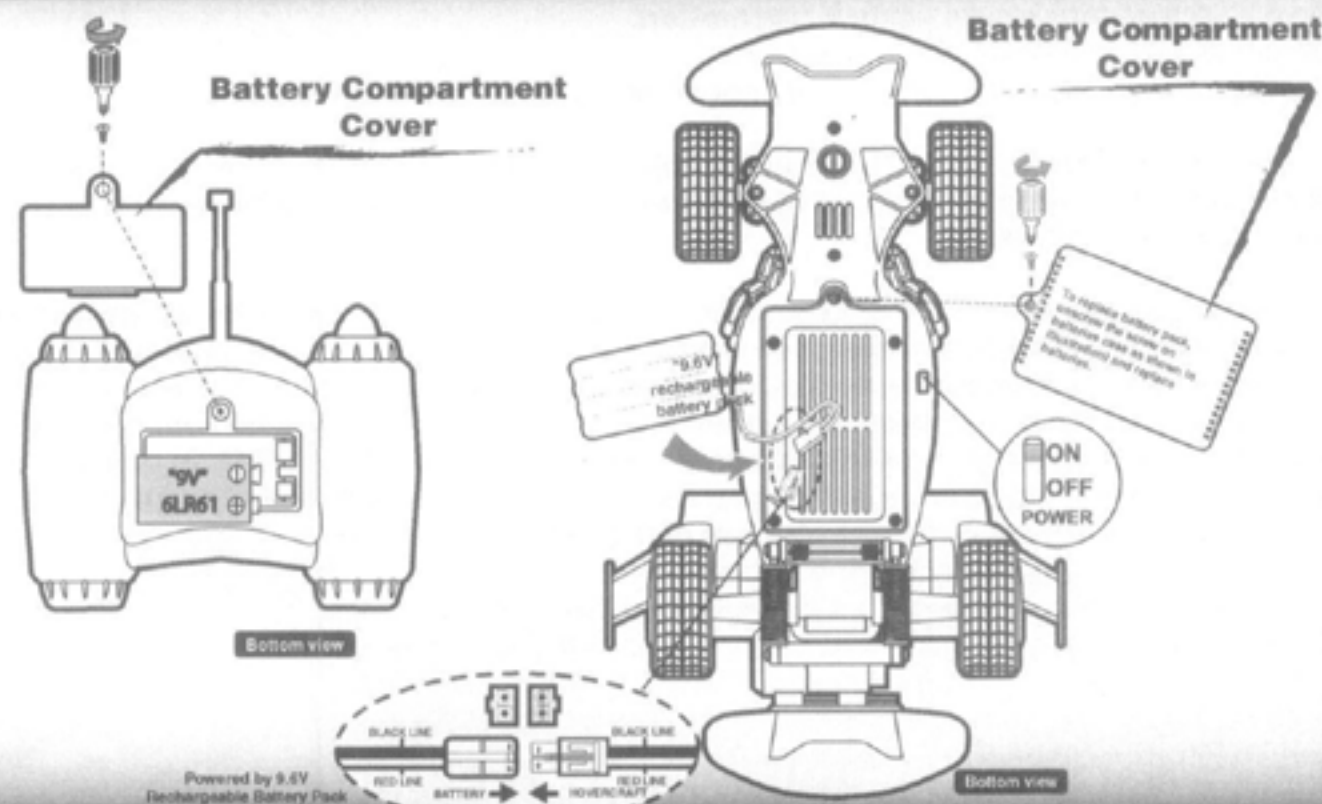
- 1) Plug the charger into a wall outlet.
- 2) Attach the charger to the battery pack as shown in the diagram. Make sure that the connectors are attached the right way up, they should slide into place smoothly and the retention clip should engage.
- 3) When the battery pack is first charged it will take around 12 hours. Charging times after the first charge will take around 3 hours.
- 4) Disconnect the battery pack from the charger by pressing down on the retention clip and pulling the connectors apart. The battery pack is now ready to be installed in the Jet Car.

Battery Installation

- 1) Plug the charger into a wall outlet.
- 2) Attach the charger to the battery pack as shown in the diagram. Make sure that the connectors are attached the right way up, they should slide into place smoothly and the retention clip should engage.
- 3) When the battery pack is first charged it will take around 12 hours. Charging times after the first charge will take around 3 hours.
- 4) Disconnect the battery pack from the charger by pressing down on the retention clip and pulling the connectors apart. The battery pack is now ready to be installed in the Jet Car.

Attention: Important Battery Information

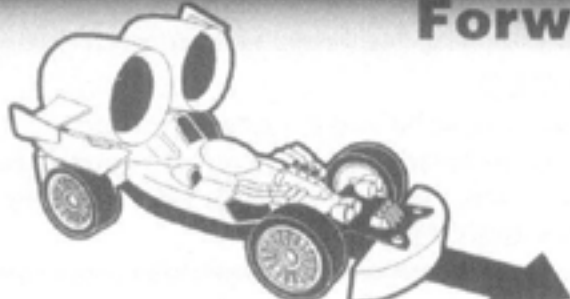
- Use only fresh batteries of the required size and recommended type.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different types of batteries (standard alkaline, or rechargeable), or rechargeable batteries of different capacities. We recommend the use of rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the toy before recharging them.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Please respect the correct polarity, (+) and (-).
- Do not dismantle batteries of any type.
- Do not try to charge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not throw batteries into the fire.
- Replace all batteries of the same type/brand at the same time.
- Do not short-circuit the battery contacts.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the toy.
- Batteries should be replaced by adults because of small parts.
- Remove batteries if the toy is not going to be played with for some time.



Driving the Jet Car

- Turn on the Jet Car and the controller using the On/Off switches.
- The power indicator light on the controller will glow as long as the battery has power.

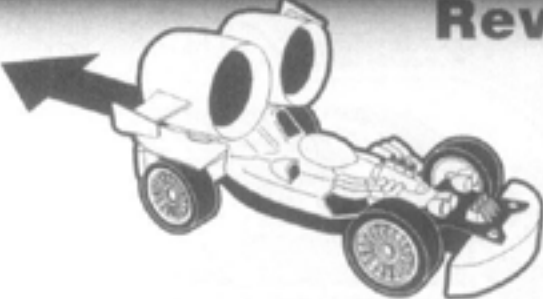
Forward



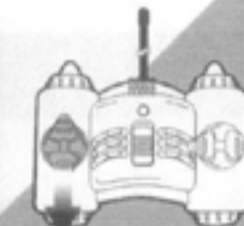
Push Forward to make the Jet Car move forwards.



Reverse



Push Reverse to make the Jet Car move backwards.



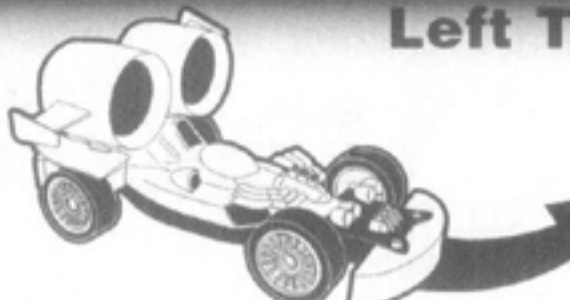
Right Turn



While pushing Forward or Reverse, push Right to make the Jet Car turn to the right.



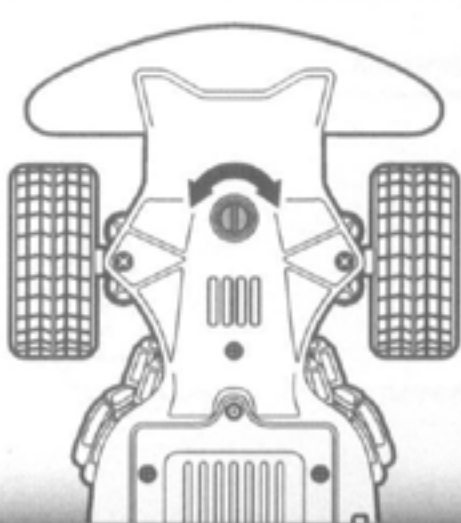
Left Turn



While pushing Forward or Reverse, push Left to make the Jet Car turn to the left.



Steering Correction



If you find that the Jet Car steers to the left or right while driving forwards or reverse, use the Steering Alignment Knob to correct the steering. If the Jet Car steers to the left, turn the Steering Alignment Knob in a counter-clockwise direction. If the Jet Car steers to the right, turn the Steering Alignment Knob in a clockwise direction. Remember that when you adjust the Steering Alignment Knob you are looking at the car from underneath so turning the knob left will make the Jet Car turn to the right and vice versa.

Driving & Safety Tips:

F.P.O

The rear wheel fenders are designed to break off in the event of a crash. They can easily be re-attached as shown in the diagram. Do not use excessive force to put them into place. The rear fender can slide off under heavy side impact. If this happens slide it back into place as shown in the diagram.



The turbojets are very powerful. Keep loose clothing, hair and small objects away from the jets while they are operating.

F.P.O

The bumpers will absorb a lot of impact but please avoid any direct collisions with heavy objects.

- When you have finished playing, make sure that you turn the On/Off switch on the controller and the Jet Car to "Off".
- Remember that when the vehicle is coming towards you, it will steer in the opposite direction to the way you turn the wheel. Try to imagine that you are in the driver's seat to work out the direction it will turn in.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires and wheels while the vehicle is in motion.
- Never drive your Jet Car on the streets.
- Do not pick up the vehicle while it is in motion.
- Do not drive the vehicle through water.
- For best results, hold the antenna up, not pointing down towards the vehicle.
