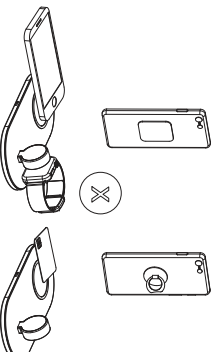

1. Insert the USB end of cable into power adaptor, and connect Micro-USB end of the cable with the wireless charger, the green LED indicator lights up after it is connected well.



2. Put your phone on the wireless charging mat. Ensure your phone center aligns with the center of rubber circle of wireless charger, or attracts your watch to the pad by magnetic attraction. Note: Using an ultra-thin protective phone case (3mm) or a case with a magnet/cuiron is not recommended as it may affect the wireless charging function.

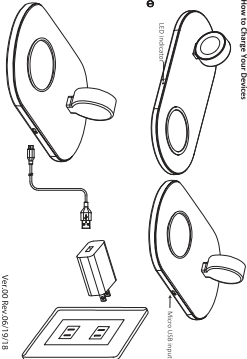

How to Charge Your Devices

- Avoid dropping.
 - Do not disassemble.
