Dear CCS TW,

I have reviewed the above referenced TCB application and find that the following items need to be addressed before the review can be completed:

1. The SAR testing was performed with this EUT USB Dongle connected directly to the USB port of the host Notebook computer (Sony). The 11mm separation provided by this particular notebook computer is arbitrary, since the actual separation could be 0cm with the dongle resting on the users lap. As the manual states, this is ¡¥suitable for any Laptop or Desktop computers.¡¹ Please provide additional SAR compliance for this USB Dongle with a 0cm separation (against the phantom).

Ans: This part had tested again. Please see Appendix I & II.

2. Additionally, the statement in the manual indicating that a 2.5cm separation is needed should be removed so that it does not cause confusion to the user.

Ans. Removed and please check page 3 again.

3. The User_i's Manual states that _i¥the operating frequency channel will be restricted to the country user located before importing._i'. Please describe how this restriction is ensured and how the user can not change the operating channels.

Ans: It would be disabled by fireware and was indicated in page 26. Please have a check again.

4. The RF Test report indicates that the Support WLAN Router was approved by FCC Declaration of 12/15/2005

Conformity. Please provide the FCC ID of this WLAN Transmitter used to support the testing. Ans: The FCC ID of the WLAN Router already added into test report.
