2.2 Assessment Results

Power density (S) is calculated according to the formula:

 $S = PG / (4\pi R^2)$

Where $S = power density in mW/cm^2$

P = Transmit power in mW

G = numeric gain of transmit antenna

R = distance (cm)

As we can see from the test report 2407B2028SHA-001:

61.7dBuV/m@3m, @20cm=@3m+40log(3/0.2)=108.74dBuV/m=0.274V/m<60.77.



RFID, LTE and WIFI/Bluetooth can transmit simultaneously, so the maximum rate of MPE is, 0.274/60.77+0.0063/1+0.1753/0.5197=0.348 < 1.0.
