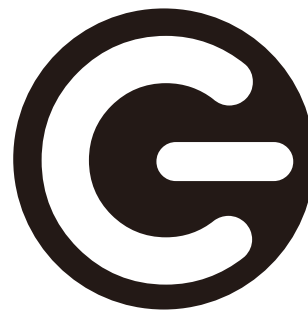

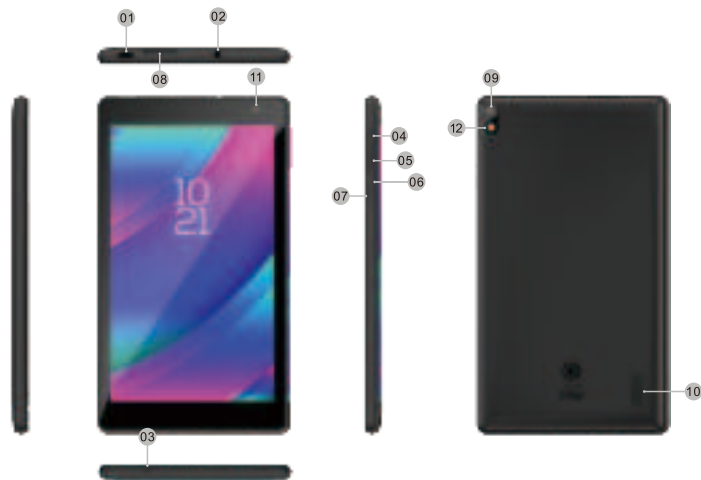
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1. Safety Notices

- ① Avoid dropping the unit on the ground or any other strong impact.
- ② Do not use in extreme cold, heat (<35 °C), excessively humid, dusty environment, and long-term use.
- ③ Try to avoid using in strong electrostatic and magnetic environment.
- ④ If water or other liquids spill on the unit, should be immediately shut down and wipe dry before use.
- ⑤ Do not use any cleaner or other liquid containing chemical ingredients to clean the device to avoid corrosion and moisture damage, if absolutely necessary cleaning, use a soft and dry cloth or paper towel.
- ⑥ If the hardware and software are not operating normally, the company is not responsible for the loss of data caused by the repair of the device in unforeseen circumstances.
- ⑦ When using the T-flash, do not remove the card to avoid damage to the memory card or device.

- ⑩ Software and manual updates can be released at any time without notice. If you find discrepancies in the Quick Guide, please refer to the device.

2. Device Overview



1. USB interface: USB interface can read and write U disk/removable hard disk and other equipment data.

2. Headphone jack: You can connect a 3.5mm stereo headset.

3. Handset: The voice of the other party can be heard during a voice call.

4. Volume up key: Press this button to increase the volume.

5. Volume down key: Press this button to decrease the volume.

6. Power button: You can use the power button to turn on/off or sleep/wake up the device.

7. Reset button: Press this button to restart the device.

8. TF slot: Support Micro SD, maximum capacity to 64GB.

9. Rear camera: You can take pictures and video.

10. Speakers: Built-in speakers allow you to hear the sound without linking extra equipment.

11. Front camera: You can take pictures and video.

12. Flash: Provides lighting for darker environments.

3. Basic Operation

3.1 Power On

Press and hold the On/Off button for 3-5 seconds and release. (Note: If there is no response when you press the power button, the device may need to recharge).

3.2 Power Off

- Press and hold the Power button for 4 seconds to enter the shutdown screen, and then select Power Off.
- Press for 10 seconds to force shutdown.

3.3 Standby

In the power-on state short press the power button to enter standby or to wake up from standby.

3.4 Restart

Press and hold the Power button for 4 seconds to enter the shutdown screen, and then select Restart.

3.5 Install TF card

Insert TF card

Insert in the slot the TF card in the direction shown in the image below. Then you can read the contents of the TF card.



3.6 Connect Network

1. In the main menu or interface, select Settings.
 2. Select Network & Internet > WiFi, the device will automatically search for the available Wifi wireless connection.
 3. Choose the WiFi connection you want to connect, if it has a password, a new window will pop up to enter the password, then select connect.
- After you're connected, you're ready to set up email, browse the web, and do many more things online.
- If WiFi isn't available, you can use a wired connection.



3.7 Connect to Bluetooth devices

Bluetooth function operation

1. Select settings in main menu.
2. Select connected devices.
3. Select Bluetooth.
4. If someone opens Bluetooth in your environment, click search for device at the top right, then the device will automatically search for the nearby Bluetooth device



5. Check if the Bluetooth device is available, a prompt popup window will appear, enter the assigned password and match the device to connect.
6. After the match successful, choose the operation you want to do.

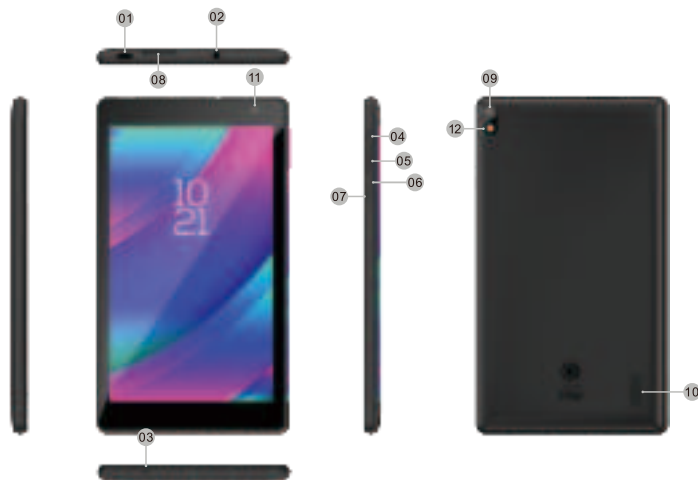
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1. Avisos de Seguridad

- ① Evite dejar caer la unidad o cualquier otro impacto fuerte.

2. Información del Dispositivo



1. Interfaz USB: La interfaz USB puede leer y escribir en disco U / disco extraíble y otros datos del equipo.

2. Conector para auriculares: Puede conectar auriculares estéreo de 3.5mm.

3. Auricular: Puede escuchar la voz durante una llamada de voz.

4. Tecla para subir el volumen: Presione este botón para subir el volumen.

5. Tecla para bajar el volumen: Presione este botón para bajar el volumen.

6. Botón de encendido/apagado: Puede usar el botón de encendido para encender, apagar, poner en reposo y activar el dispositivo.

7. Botón de reinicio: Presiona el botón de reseteo para reiniciar el dispositivo.

8. Entrada TF: Admite tarjetas Micro SD con capacidad máxima de 64GB.

9. Cámara trasera: Puede tomar fotos y grabar video.

10. Altavoces: Los altavoces incorporados le permiten escuchar el sonido sin conectar equipos adicionales.

11. Cámara frontal: Proporciona iluminación para ambientes más oscuros.

12. Luz de flash: Proporciona iluminación para ambientes más oscuros.

3. Operación Básica

3.1 Encendido

Mantenga presionado el botón de encendido durante 3-5 segundos y suéltelo. (Nota: Si no hay respuesta cuando presione el botón de encendido, es posible que el dispositivo deba recargarse).

3.2 Apagado

- Mantenga presionado el botón de Encendido durante 4 segundos para ingresar a la pantalla de apagado y luego seleccione Apagar.
- Presione durante 10 segundos para forzar el apagado.

3.3 Reposo

En estado de encendido, presione brevemente el botón de encendido para ingresar al modo de espera o despertar del modo de espera.

3.4 Reinicio

Mantenga presionado el botón de encendido durante 4 segundos.

3.5 Instalar la Tarjeta SIM y la Tarjeta TF

• Inserte la Tarjeta TF

Inserte la tarjeta TF en la dirección como se muestra en la siguiente imagen. Esto le permitirá leer el contenido de la tarjeta TF.



3.6 Conectar a la Red

1. En el menú principal seleccione configuración.
2. Seleccione Red e Internet > WiFi, el dispositivo buscará automáticamente la red de internet inalámbrico WiFi disponible.
3. Elija la red WiFi que desea conectar, si requiere de alguna contraseña, aparecerá la ventana de contraseña, ingrese la contraseña y seleccione conectar. Una vez conectado, está listo para configurar el correo electrónico, navegador por la web y hacer muchas otras cosas en línea. Si el WiFi no está disponible, puede usar una conexión por cable.



3.7 Conectar a Dispositivos Bluetooth

Función de Bluetooth

1. Seleccione configuración en la interfaz del menú principal.
2. Seleccione dispositivos conectados.
3. Seleccione Bluetooth.
4. Si alguien abre Bluetooth en su entorno, haga click en buscar dispositivo en la parte superior derecho. La unidad buscará automáticamente el dispositivo Bluetooth cercano.

This device was tested for typical body-worn operations.
