



# **Getting Started**

#### Loading Battery




Push the OPEN switch on the camcorder  $\bigcirc$ bottom to open th attery compartment slot  $\bigcirc$ Insert the lithium battery in the direction of matching positive and negative poles. Press the battery compartment slot to close Note: Slide the battery lock with your fingernail and it will eject automatically.

## **Inserting SD Card**



- $\bigcirc$ Push the OPEN switch on the camcorder bottom to open $\mathbf{\nabla}$ battery compartment
  - Insert the memory card according to the direction shown until it clicks.
  - Press the battery compartment slot to close it.

## **Charging Battery**

- ① Open the USB port cover on the device.
- ② Connect the camcorder to the charging adapter (package not included) with USB cable to charge the battery.
- ③ The "CHG" indicator light will be red during charging and the indicator light will be turned off when fully charged.

#### Power On/Off

- Power On: Open the LCD monitor and the camcorder will automatically turn on. If the monitor has been opened, press and hold POWER button to turn on the device.
- ② Power Off: Close the LCD monitor or press POWER button to turn off the device.


#### Formatting Memory Card

To ensure the stable operation of the memory card, please format it according to the following steps when the first use or changing it.

- ① Power on the camera.
- 2 Press MODE button.
- ③ Touch Setup icon.
- ④ Push W/T button to select Format.
- 5 Press PHOTO button to confirm.
- 6 Touch Yes icon to complete the formatting.





- Power on the camcorder → Press MODE button → Touch Video icon on the screen to enter Video Mode.
- Press MENU button to set the optional functions. Please refer to section of Setting Video.
- ③ Push the W/T button to adjust zoom.
- ④ Press the REC button to start recording.
- 5 Press the PHOTO button to pause/continue recording.
- 6 Press the REC button to stop recording.

Note: The camcorder will automatically stop recording when the recording duration reaches 15 minutes.


#### Setting Video

- ① In the video mode, press the MENU button to enter the video setting interface.
- 2 Push W/T button to select the options.
- ③ Press the PHOTO button to confirm.
- ④ Touch 📰 icon to back to the previous menu.



- ③ Press W/T button to adjust the zoom.
- ④ Half press PHOTO button to focus and fully press PHOTO button to take a photo.

#### Setting Photo

- ① In the photo mode, press the MENU button to enter the photo setting interface.
- 2 Push W/T button to select the options.
- ③ Press the PHOTO button to confirm.
- ④ Touch 🛅 icon to back to previous menu interface.





#### Notes:

· BurstMode is enabled only when the photo resolution is set to 10M or less.

· When the macro function is enabled, switching to recording mode will not

focus.

You need to close the macro function before switching.

· When the focus is adjusted to a larger range, we recommend mounting a

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

# Playback Mode


- ① Press MODE button  $\rightarrow$  Touch Playback icon on the screen.
- ② Touch Video icon or Photo icon to enter the file preview interface.
- ③ When browsing the video, touch 🔲 to play, press PHOTO button to pause or continue playing.
- ④ Touch MENU icon to enter delete or protect function interface → Push W/T button to select → Press PHOTO button to enter the next menu → Touch YES or NO icon to end the selection.



# **Remote Control**

- ① Open the battery compartment cover of the remote controller.
- Insert two 1.5v AAA batteries (Package not included).
- ③ Close the battery compartment cover.
- ④ The distance of the remote control is approximately 10m.

# Downloading the APP

Using the browser of smartphone to scan the QR code or search for "VD Cam(Video Dimension Camera)" on App Store. For Android users, search for "VD Cam" on Google Play.



### **Connecting Wi-Fi**

- ① Power on the device.
- ② Press MODE button  $\rightarrow$  Touch Wi-Fi icon on the screen.

③ Open Wi-Fi on your smartphone, and then search for the Wi-Fi name OPZM-10-SSID

number, enter the default password: 12345678.

- ④ Open the app, touch connect camera icon.
- (5) After connecting, you can set the parameters, start/stop recording, take photos, view and download the footages and photos through your smartphone.

#### Notes:

 Do not change the Wi-Fi name and password, it may affect the abnormal access


of the memory card.

- · The maximum connection distance is approximately 10 meters.
- $\cdot$  After the camcorder is connected to your smartphone, it can only be controlled

through the app or remote controller to record or take photos, not the screen

# **Connecting to Computer & HD TV**


### **Connecting to Computer**



The camcorder can be used as a MSDC or PC camera.

- ① Power on the device.
- ② Connect the camcorder to computer with the USB cable.
- ③ MSDC & PC Camera options display on the camcorder screen, push W/T button to select, then press PHOTO button to confirm.

## Connecting to HD TV



- ① Power on the device.
- ② Connect the HD cable to the camcorder HD Out port.
- ③ Connect the other end of the cable
- (4) to a High-Definition television.
- (5) Set the video input source of your TV to HDMI, then the preview screen will display on the TV.

Trouble	Possible Reason	Solution
Cannot power on	Battery is not inserted correctly	Insert battery correctly/
	Low battery power	Replace the battery or charge the battery
Cannot take photos and record videos	Memory card is full	Cut stored video/image files to your computer
	Recording duration over 15 minutes	Press REC button to recording
Automatically stops recording	Low battery power	Replace the battery or charge the battery
	SD card storage is full	Delete some files or replace the SD card

# Troubleshooting

Fail to use it as a webcam	USB cable port is loose	Replace the USB interface
Recorded video without sound	Sound is turned off on the app	Turn on sound on the app or restore the camcorder to its default settings
Cannot change the resolution of photos	BurstMode function is on	Check the status of BurstMode and turn off it
Slomo function cannot be enabled	Adjusted the resolution after turning it on	Re-enable Slomo function
Cannot enter the video setting interface	Camera pauses recording	Press to PHOTO button to continue recording, the press to REC button to stop recording
Stuck or disconnected after connecting to the phone	/	Switch off cellular data on the phone and reconnect it again

#### Precautions

- ① Do not drop, impact or puncture the camera.

charged.

③ If there is dust or dirt on the lens or screen, gently wipe it with a soft lens cleaning cloth.
