### USA - Federal Communications Commission (FCC)

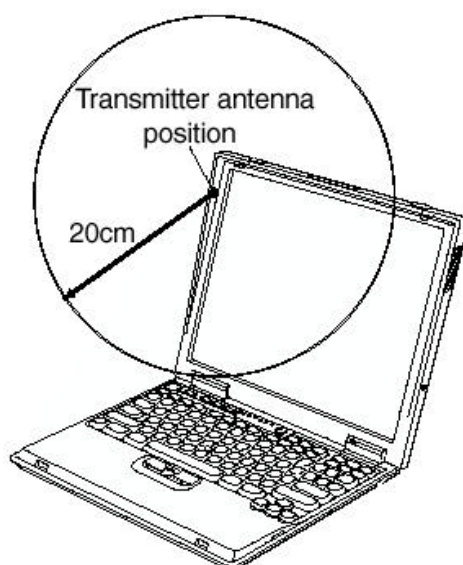
This device complies with part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

### The FCC RF Safety Requirement
