I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Before we begin our formal review, we will need a few more Exhibits uploaded to our website. Please Provide the following:

External Photographs (as separate exhibit). If this is a circuit card, show the device with all shields and covers attached for this view.

Schematics Block Diagram (as separate exhibit)

Confidentiality Request Letter (if desired). No additional charge for Confidentiality.

Test Setup Photos

Modular Request Letter (see attached document from FCC)

- 2) The Receiver can be programmed to receive anywhere in the 902-928 MHz band. It is unusual that the Transmitter cannot be programmed over the same frequency range as the Receiver. Please provide a better explanation. If so, then three channels must be tested in the 902-928MHz band for carrier field strength and Tx spurious emissions.
- 3) FYI: With regard to Form 731: For low power Part 15 transmitters, RF Pout, Frequency Tolerance, Emission Designator and Microprocessor Model Number can be ignored. This is true with the FCC as well as AmericanTCB.
- 4) Please provide photographs and description (gain, manufacturer, connector, etc.) of the antenna for use with the device/board.
- 5) The operational description states that the device contains an integral antenna (Section 3.4), yet the internal photographs show an antenna connector. Please explain.
- 6) Please provide a photograph or drawing that shows the placement of the label on the device.
- 7) FYI: A complete technical review can not be completed until all exhibits have been provided.
