We at Intel Corporation at 2111 NE 25th Ave. Hillsboro, OR, 97124 attest that the original filing for the Intel® Pro/Wireless 3945abg Network Connection labeled with FCC ID: PD9LEN3945ABG is only manufactured for a specific OEM. The original application did not include bios lock, chassis and antenna information from the OEM due to the fact that this data at the time was not available. There were no devices sold to the OEM during this time for distribution, the original approval was completed ahead of time to expedite the process once the bios lock, chassis and antenna information was made available. Upon receipt of those documents we submitted a Class II Permissive Change adding the bios lock, chassis and antenna information. Once that Class II Permissive Change approval was received the OEM was enabled and started to receive Intel® Pro/Wireless 3945abg Network Connection labeled with FCC ID: PD9LEN3945ABG products from Intel Corporation with a specific Device ID which is used in conjunction with the system Bios Lock, this information was supplied in the Class II Permissive Change application approved on 12/13/2005. Subsequent Class II Permissive Change applications have been submitted adding additional chassis and antenna information to this FCC ID: PD9LEN3945ABG all of which include the specific Device ID and Bios Lock.
