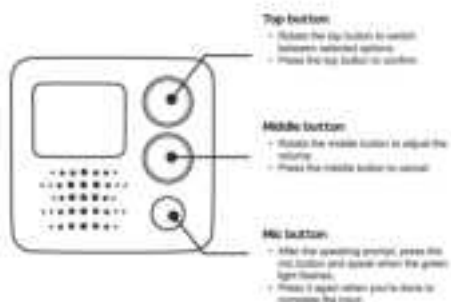


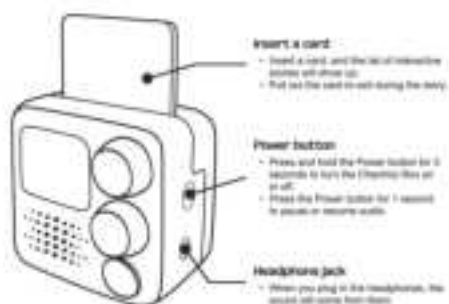

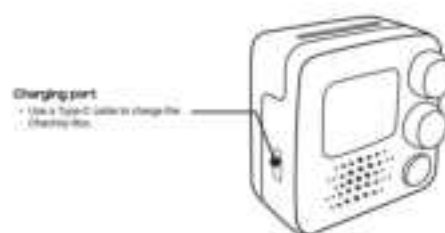
Front view
