Overview

Congratulations on your purchase of the RF Internet Wireless Keyboard. The RF Internet Wireless Keyboard combines a standard keyboard layout with 13 convenient Multimedia Buttons which control the following:

- CD control buttons: Play/Pause, Previous, Next, and Stop.
- Volume control buttons: Volume Up, Volume Down, and Mute
- World Wide Web site buttons: Internet browser, and E-mail.
- Re-definable control buttons: The function of button can be re-defined

System Requirement

Before installing the RF Internet Wireless Keyboard software, please make sure that the hardware connections of your keyboard are correctly set up. The following system specifications are required:

1. IBM PC compatible system
2. Microsoft® Windows® 95, 98, 2000 or NT4.0
3. CD-ROM drive (for CD and Video operation)
4. Standard sound card (for CD and Video operation)

When using the 3 power management buttons, particular requirements are needed:

- Microsoft® Windows® 98 or 2000 Operating System
- The system supporting ACPI or APM II

- **ATX mother board and ATX power supply**

Installation

§ Hardware Installation

Connect RF Internet Wireless Keyboard's receiver to your computer.

Note: always turn off your computer before you connect or disconnect your mouse and keyboard unless you are using a USB device in Win98. If you have a PC with the PC99 spec, then the mouse port and keyboard port are green and purple respectively.

1. Connect the receiver's green mouse connector to the computer's 6-pin mouse port. Connect the receiver's purple keyboard connector to the computer's 6-pin keyboard port.
2. Install four AA batteries in the keyboard.

§ Software Installation for Windows operation system

Please follow the instructions below on how to install the IR/RF Internet Wireless Keyboard software to your PC system.







1. Please insert the floppy disk included in your package, labeled "Multimedia Keyboard Driver" into your drive A.
2. Simply double-click on the *setup.exe* to continue the installation procedure.
3. Follow all the on-screen instructions.

§ Uninstall

1. From the Windows Start Menu, locate uninstall under **Programs Files\Multimedia Keyboard V1.0**
2. Double-click on *Uninstall Multimedia Keyboard* to uninstall the driver.
