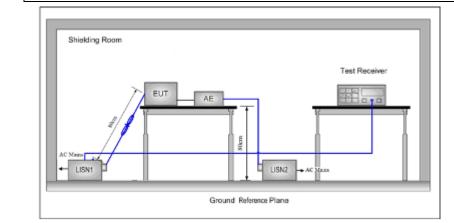

Test Setup:

Test Procedure:

- a The mains terminal disturbance voltage was measured with the EUT in a shielded room.
- b The EUT was connected to AC power source through a LISN 1 (Line Impedance Stabilization Network) which provides $50\Omega/50\mu$ H + 5Ω linear impedance. The power cables of all other units of the EUT were connected to a second LISN, which was bonded to the ground reference plane in the same way as the LISN for the unit being measured. A multiple socket outlet strip was used to connect multiple power cables to a single LISN provided the rating of the LISN was not exceeded
- c The tabletop EUT was placed upon a non-metallic table 0.8m above the ground reference plane. And for floor-standing arrangement, the EUT was placed on the horizontal ground reference plane, but separated from metallic contact with the ground reference plane by 0.1m of insulation.
- d The test was performed with a vertical ground reference plane. The rear of the EUT shall be 0.4 m from the vertical ground reference plane. The vertical ground reference plane was bonded to the horizontal ground reference plane. The LISN was placed 0.8 m from the boundary of the unit under test and bonded to a ground reference plane for LISN mounted on top of the ground reference plane. This distance was between the closest points of the LISN and the EUT. The mains lead of EUT excess 0.8m was folded back and forth parallel to the lead so as to form a horizontal bundle with a length between 0.3m and 0.4m. All other units of the EUT and associated equipment were at least 0.8 m from the LISN.

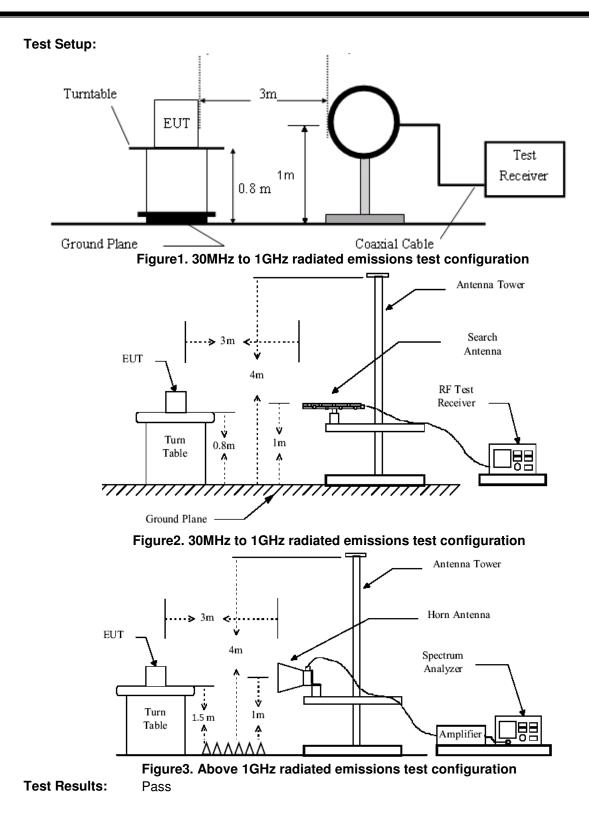

Test Procedure:	 a. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 3 meter semi-anechoic camber. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation. b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower. c. The antenna height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement. d.
