## **CHARGING YOUR EARBUDS**

• When the red indicator LED blinks three times every one minute, the battery is low. To charge the battery, plug the microUSB charging cable into your computer and into the microUSB port on your earbuds. The red LED turns on to indicate that the battery is charging and turns off when fully charged.

## **USING YOUR EARBUDS**

Turning your earbuds on and off

#### 1 Place the earbud cable around your neck, then clip the cable clamp to your collar. The inline control falls naturally in front of your right shoulder.

2 Press and hold the **MFB** for three seconds The LFD blinks blue (when turned on) or red (when turned off) and the voice prompt says "Power on", or "Power off."

1	▲ Volume Up Next Track	Press to $\blacktriangle$ increase the volume. Press to $\blacklozenge$ skip to the next track.
2	Micro USB port	Plug the micro USB connector into this port to charge your earbuds.
3	Multi-function button (MFB) (Power/Talk/Play/ Pause/Pairing)	Press to turn on your earbuds. If you receive a phone call, press to talk. Press to turn off your earbuds.
4	▼ Volume Down Previous Track	Press to ▼ decrease the volume. Press to ▼ skip to the previous track.
5	Indicator LED	Shows the current status of the earbuds.
6	Microphone	Allows you to talk on the telephone.

## **PAIRING YOUR EARBUDS**

- Notes: Range is 33 feet (10 meters)
- Supports easy pairing
- Prompts you by saying "Device Connected," when connected
- Supports a battery indicator icon on an iOS device

#### Pairing with a cell phone or MP3 player

- 1 With your earbuds turned off, press and hold **MFB** for four seconds. The blue and red LEDs blink alternately.
- 2 On your phone or MP3 player, select NS-CAHBTSPORT from the list of discovered devices, then enter the password **0000** (four zeros) (if required) to pair your earbuds. For more information on pairing Bluetooth devices to your cell phone or MP3 player, see the device's documentation.

Note: After the earbuds have been successfully paired with the cell phone or MP3 player, the earbuds will automatically reconnect to the phone or MP3 player.

## Pairing with a computer running Windows

- Note: Before you pair the earbuds with the computer, make sure that the computer is equipped with Bluetooth. Refer to the computer's documentation or contact the computer manufacturer for more information. If your computer is not Bluetooth compatible, install a Bluetooth USB adapter (dongle).
- 1 Turn on Bluetooth on the computer. For instructions, see the computer's documentation or contact the computer manufacturer.
- 2 Double-click the Bluetooth icon in the system tray, then click Add a device (Add Wireless Device using Windows Vista).
- 3 With the earbuds turned off, press and hold MFB for four seconds. The LED blinks blue and red alternately. Pairing mode is activated. **4** Double-click the **NS-CAHBTSPORT** icon on the computer or highlight the icon, then click
- Next.
- Note: If you are unable to locate the NS-CAHBTSPORT icon, click the Search Again button.
- 5 If required, enter 0000 (four zeros) in the Bluetooth security code field, then click Next. 6 After the earbuds have been paired, click **Close**. If you are using Windows XP, continue with steps 7 through 9.
- 7 Select one of the Bluetooth hands-free types shown on the Add a Bluetooth Device Wizard screen, then click **Next**.
- 8 Select the services shown on the wizard screen to use with your Bluetooth earbuds, then click Finish.
- 9 To connect the device, double-click the NS-CAHBTSPORT Hands-Free Unit icon or the NS-CAHBTSPORT Stereo Audio icon. Note: The earbuds should be automatically selected as the default playback device (Windows® 8, Windows® 7, or

Windows Vista®) or the default recording and playback device (Windows XP). To make those settings manually, refer to the User Guide.

## Pairing with a Mac computer
