#### TEST PROCEDURE

GENERAL: This report shall NOT be reproduced except in full without the written approval of TIMCO ENGINEERING, INC.

RADIATION INTERFERENCE: The test procedure used was ANSI STANDARD C63.4-1992 using a HEWLETT PACKARD spectrum analyzer with a preselector. The bandwidth of the spectrum analyzer was 100 kHz with an appropriate sweep speed. The analyzer was calibrated in dB above a microvolt at the output of the antenna. The resolution bandwidth was 100KHz and the video bandwidth was 300KHz. The ambient temperature of the UUT was 79oC with a humidity of 70%.

FORMULA OF CONVERSION FACTORS: The Field Strength at 3m was established by adding the meter reading of the spectrum analyzer (which is set to read in units of dBuV) to the antenna correction factor supplied by the antenna manufacturer. The antenna correction factors are stated in terms of dB. The gain of the Preselector was accounted for in the Spectrum Analyzer Meter Reading.

ANSI STANDARD C63.4-1992 10.1.7 MEASUREMENT PROCEDURES: The unit under test was placed on a table 80 cm high and with dimensions of 1m by 1.5m. The table used for radiated measurements is capable of continuous rotation.

When an emission was found, the table was rotated to produce the maximum signal strength. At this point, the antenna was raised and lowered from 1m to 4m. The antenna was placed in both the horizontal and vertical planes.

The situation was similar for the conducted measurement except that the table did not rotate. The EUT was setup as described in ANSIC63.4-1992 with the EUT 40 cm from the vertical ground wall.

### CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

In the transmit mode the momentary switches S1, S2, S3, & S4 provide input to the encoder intergrated circuit U1. The output of U1 modulated the RF output stage Q2. The crystal controlled oscillator Q1 is coupled to Q2 via C10. From Q2 the signal goes to the double tuned circuit made up of L3, C5, L2, C7 & C8 which is connected to the antenna. The RF frequency is determined by the crystal Y1.

### ANTENNA\_AND\_GROUND\_CIRCUITRY

This unit makes use of a short, antenna. The antenna is inductively coupled. The antenna is self contained, no provision is made for an external antenna. This unit is powered from a 9.0V battery.

No ground connection is provided. The unit relies on the ground tract of the printed circuit board.

## SAMPLE CALCULATION:

FSdBuV/m = MR(dBuV) + ACFdB.

TEST PROCEDURE: The procedure used was ANSI STANDARD C63.4-1992. The spectrum was scanned from 30 MHz to 1000 MHz. When an emission was found, the table was rotated to produce the maximum signal strength. The antenna was placed in both the horizontal and vertical planes and the worse case emissions were reported. The UUT was tested in 3 orthogonal planes.

THE GRAPH IN EXHIBIT 12 REPRESENTS THE WORSE CASE OCCUPPIED BANDWIDTH EMISSIONS FOR THIS DEVICE.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT: A small sample of the transmitter output was fed into the spectrum analyzer and the attached plot was taken. The vertical scale is set to  $-10~\mathrm{dBm}$  per division. The horizontal scale is set to  $5~\mathrm{kHz}$  per division.

TEST RESULTS: The unit DOES meet the FCC requirements.
