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1Introduction

1.1 Acknowledgement

Thanks for your purchase of our product **tablet** is a 7 inches high clear board computer. Its CPU is MT8788 with 8 cores, it is based on Android 11.0 operation system, and easy to expand the third application procedure.

The product is designed with various functions, including WIFI, Bluetooth, GPS, FM, voice call and so on. It is easy to achieve wireless communication and internet, you have access to surf the internet anytime and anywhere; it is also built with high accuracy GPS module, so that it can be used for navigating through installing map software. There are many sensors which offer you brand-new operation and entertainment; besides, it has camera shooting, which leads electronic consumption to enter a fresh palm internet entertainment time.

The manual systemically introduces the functions, use techniques and announcements, please read this manual carefully before your operation.

1.2 Announcements

Preventive maintenance

2.2 MID Operation and Preparation

Battery Charging

If you use the MID for the first time, please fully charge it with the supplied power adapter. It

is recommended that the battery be recharged every 6 months.

2.3MID Status and Reminder

Reminder icons

When some reminder message appears in your reminder window, please click the column and slip the screen to open the reminder list. Choose the menu you need and confirm the information. You can close the reminder window by clicking the column to slide up. Please refer to the below status icons:

Reminder icons will work while receiving emails, WIFI is open, and you can open the reminder board to view the detailed information.

When the reminder column shows new reminder icon, please hold the column and slip down your finger, then the reminder board is opened.

3 Sleepy's Elite APP Instruction

You can find the app for the second page. The app supports landscape/portrait screens and two styles of day/night. The following description takes a portrait/daytime screen as an example.

3.1Add a device



After opening the app, the home page will be displayed. Click the OPEN page to enter the next page.



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When you first open the app, it will show No Device Added in the picture above. Click the Add Sleepy's Elite button to add a device.

- On the add device page, it will search for Bluetooth signals around. Click the Refresh button in the upper right corner to search again. Click the device in the list to connect (the one that starts with Star is CB.25 control box, and the one that starts with OKIN is CB.36 control box. If you connect CB.36 control box, you need to pair it in the pop-up window. The form of the pop-up window may be different for different phones.)
- After a successful connection, it will enter the test interface, click the Pairing Test button, the backrest goes up, and stop when released. Click the Done button to go back to the home page.

3.2Control the motors

There are five icons on the bottom. Click the first button at the bottom of the home page to switch to the motor control interface. -CB.25



- Drag the (Head/Foot/Core Support) disc and release it, the motor will move to the specified position.
- Click (Ascent/Relax/Zero Gravity/AntiSnore/Flat), the motor will move to the specified position.
- Press and hold the key combination (Ascent+Program/Relax+Program/Zero Gravity+ Program) for 3s to save the current memory position, and pop-up window will prompt.
- Press and hold the key combination (Flat+Program) for 3s to reset the memory position to the factory settings, and pop-up window will appear.

• Drag the (Head/Foot/Core Support) disc to the left, the motor goes down. Drag the disc to the right, the motor goes up and releases to stop.

- Click (Ascent/Relax/Zero Gravity/AntiSnore/Flat) button, the motor will move to the specified position.
- Press and hold the key combination (Ascent+Program/Relax+Program/Zero Gravity+ Program) for 3s to save the current memory position and pop-up window will prompt.
- Press and hold the key combination (Flat+Program) for 3s to reset the memory position to the factory settings, and pop-up window will appear.

3.3 Massage

Click the second button at the bottom of the home page to switch to the Massage interface.

- Click the Turn On button to turn on the massage. After turning on the massage, the button will become Turn Off, click Turn Off to turn off the massage.
- When the massage is on, drag the upper sliding bar to adjust the massage intensity.
- When massage is on, click Mode1/Mode2/Mode3 button to switch to massage mode.
- When massage is on, click the 10 Min/20 Min/30 Min button to switch massage time.

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- Click the Turn On button to turn on the massage, the button will become Turn Off, click Turn Off to turn off the massage.
- When the massage is on, drag the upper disc to adjust the massage intensity.
- When massage is on, click Mode1/Mode2/Mode3 button to switch the massage mode.
- The duration of the massage is 15Min, not adjustable.

3.4Underbed light

• Click the Turn On button to turn on the light. After turning on the light, the button turns to

Turn Off and click Turn Off to turn off the light.

- When the light is on, drag the upper disc to adjust the brightness of the light.
- When the light is on, click the arrow or click the specified color block to switch the light color.

- Click the right arrow to turn on the light or switch the color.
- Drag the upper disc to adjust the brightness (If the light is off, it will not turn on the light).
- Press and hold the Turn Off button for 3 seconds to turn off the light.

3.5 Voice control



Click the microphone button below to call out the voice control pop-up window.

- ADD DEVICES: Click to add devices interface.

- SUPPORT: Click to support interface.

4.2On and Off

On

Long press **the POWER key for three seconds**, and you can enter the startup picture. The system enters screen lock status, please unlock it.

Off

- 1. Long press POWER, it will pop up a window.
- 2. It contains Restart, Screenshot and Power off three options.
- 3. Click Power off is the last step.

4.3Open and Close of the Screen

Close the screen

- 1. The screen will be closed on its own if no operation happens for some time to save battery power.
- 2. When the screen is open, press the POWER key, and the screen will be closed immediately.

If the screen is closed, short press POWER to open the screen. The screen will be locked open, it will show the picture below, slide to unlock the screen.

4.4Usage of Touch Screen

MID operating methods

There are below methods to view the main screen, menu and application procedure in your MID.

Click

When you want to use the screen, keyboard typing or choose an application in the main interface, you only need to touch it with your finger.

Press on

If you want to open some item (textbox or the link in the webpage), or shortcut and main procedure move, you can press on this item.

Quickly slide or slide

Quickly slide or slide indicates to make quick vertical or horizontal movement by finger.

Pull

Before you pull, you need to hold it with strength until you pull it into the position you want.

Rotate

For most pictures, you only need to rotate the MID sidewise to change the screen direction from horizontal to vertical. For instance, when you are typing words, and watching movies.

4.5Home Page

The main interface as below picture 4.2, long press the blank and it will pop up windows to set Wallpapers, Widgets, and Home settings.

The extended home page

The home page can be extended beyond the wideness of the screen to provide more space, where you can put new-added shortcuts and widgets. Click the blank space on the home page then slide right or left to extend to the right or left of the screen. On the home page, there are two extended pictures, as in Picture 3.3.

Create a folder icon on the desktop

- 1. Drag the icons that need to be put together on one icon.
- 2. Then click the overlaid icons, the applications can be folded, as in Picture 3.5..

Click the unnamed folder in the black box, and it will pop up the hidden keyboard, the folder name can be renamed (this is similar to the Apple IOS system), and the icon position can be changed through a long press.

Remove the icons on the desktop

1. Long press the icons that need to be removed, then on the right above the screen, it

4.6 Type-C(USB) Connection

MID storage configuration

Before transmitting documents, you have to conduct storage configuration for your MID:

- 1. Connect the MID and computer by Type-C(USB) cable, the reminder column will show the reminder information.
- 2. Open the reminder board; please view the MID status and reminder to learn how to open the board.
- 3. In the reminder board, there are two choices "Use for extra tablet storage" and "Use for portable storage", choose the item you need.
- 4. Now the USB is connected successfully.

Copy the document into the memory card

- 1. Connect the MID to the computer with a USB cable.
- 2. As a MID storage configuration, it is connected to the computer successfully.
- 3. Open the "My computer" in your computer, and check the items in "removable disc".
- 4. Copy the documents you need into "removable disc".
- 5. After copying finishes, click "shutdown the USB storage configuration" to uninstall.

4.7 Typing words

Use the screen keyboard

When you start the procedure or choose the words or numbers edition, it will show the screen keyboard. The keyboard defaults to Google Input method.

Choose the typing method

- 1. Click the Setting icon.
- 2. Click Languages.
- 3. In the text setting area will reveal all the installed words-typing methods in your MID.
- 4. Choose the typing method you want.

4.8 Operation Technique

Create Application shortcut icons

Long press the blank, and it will pop up a window. Click the Widgets, it will switch to the widgets interface. Click the corresponding arrow of the app, touch and hold to move a widget to create its shortcut icon. Drag and hold the icon, and you can move to any position on the desktop. and then you can enter the application through the icon.

Remind: If the target position has no space, the widget cannot be added in the main screen.

5 Wireless and Internet

5.1Connect WIFI

1. Choose setting application procedure.

- 2. Click Network&internet, open Internet. MID will automatically search the available WIFI wireless internet. As Picture 5.1
- 3. Choose the WIFI internet you want to connect to. If it has the password, it will pop up the password window, enter the password, and click connect.

5.14 Date and Time

According to the present, the system will voluntarily apply the date, zone, and time provided by the Internet.

Manual set date, time and zone

- 1. Click the Setting application procedure.
- 2. Slide down the screen, then clicksystem, then click date and timeas Picture 5.21.
- 3. Turn off "use network provided time".
- 4. Turn off "automatic setting zone'.
- 5. Click Zone Selecting, then choose the zone lists. Slide down the list to view more zones.
- 6. Click **Date setting**, then click the upper or down button to adjust the date, month, and year, then click **setting** when you finish the selection.
- 7. Click the **Time setting**, then click the upper or down button to adjust the hour and minute, and click AM or PM to change the morning or afternoon (there is no such selection when you see the 24-hour format). Click **Setting** to finish.
- 8. Click **24-hour format**, and switch between 12-hour or 24-hour format, the time format you choose will be used on the alarm clock.
- 9. Click the date format setting, then choose the time format you want to show on MID.

6 Multi-Media

6.1Photos

Photo gallery application can auto-search photos and video files on an SD card, and photo gallery will classify these photos and videos in a folder. You can apply photo gallery to view and edit photos, set the photos as wallpaper and watch the video.

View pictures

- 1. Click the gallery application in the main interface.
- 2. Enter the gallery and click the folder you want to view.
- 3. Click the picture you want to view; the system will play it in full screen mode automatically.
- 4. The pictures can be zoomed in and zoomed out, put two fingers on the screen, separate the fingers (gather up the fingers, and the picture will be zoomed in) or double-click the screen.

Note: when you browse the pictures, slide left or right to view more pictures.

Edit and set pictures

When checking the pictures in full-screen mode, click menu key to display the menu selection, you can choose the selection you need to edit and set pictures.

Slide Show

- 1. Open a picture, use virtual key to click menu key, and display the menu selection.
- 2. Click slide show, it will auto-loop play (or choose button in picture folder)

Crop

- 1. Click the menu key to display the menu selection.
- 2. Then click crop, click, and drag the related area to adjust the cropper.
- 3. Click Cropper and drag it inside and outside to adjust the image.
- 4. After adjusting the size you want, click crop.
- 5. If you wish to give up cropping, click **cancel** to return to picture browse.

Edit

- 1. Click menu key and display the menu selection.
- 2. Click edit.
- 3. Adjust the brightness, style, colour, and antialias setting in selection.

- 4. Click save.
- 5. If you want to give up editing, click the return key, and click not to return to picture browse.

6.2Camera

In the main interface or desktop, click the camera application procedure \square , enter camera.

8 Troubles Shooting

8.1 The first startup of MID is slow.

After the MID system is upgraded, the first startup needs to install the pre-installed application software, the lead time is around 2-3 minutes, and the startup afterwards will be much quicker.

8.2 MID can't connect to WIFI.

- Make sure the wireless router of internet service can work normally.
- Ensure the MID and wireless router in a certain distance, and no wall or other barrier between them.
- Ensure the username and password are both correct.

8.3 MID heating

When many application procedures are used in the meanwhile, or the brightness of the screen opens to the lightest or undercharging. The temperature of the device rises. It is normal.

8.4 Email can't be set or Registration of application procedure.

- Ensure your internet is well connected.
- Make sure your email setting way is correct.
- Keep your system time and local time consistent.

8.5The system is abnormal and can't work.
