Baby Unit has infrared LEDs that allow you to see your baby clearly at night or in a dark room. When Black and White Night Vision mode is activated, 📞 appears on the screen. When Color Night Vision mode is activated, 📜 appears on the screen.

 If you adjust the night vision mode while night vision is not activated, the new settings will be saved and applied the next time it activates.
