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

GUN CALIBRATION

Gun Calibration is used to adjust the sighting and accuracy of the gun. Follow the on-screen instructions to correctly calibrate your gun. **HOW TO CALIBRATE YOUR GUN:**

1. Turn machine ON.
2. Hold down GUN1 start button and GUN2 start button at the same time for 5 seconds to bring up the adjustment menu.

3. Navigate to "GUN CALIBRATION" using the gun trigger. . Press GUN1 start button to confirm Follow on-screen instructions.

NOTE: Keep the gun at least 15" (38cm) away from the cabinet and be sure the gun is positioned in the center of the screen.
