## Limits for Maximum Permissible Exposure (MPE)

F = frequency in MHz

Formula: Pd = (Pout\*G)/(4\*  $\pi$  \*r<sup>2</sup>)

Where :

 $Pd = power density in mW/cm^2$ ,

Pout = output power to antenna in mW;

G = gain of antenna in linear scale,

 $\pi = 3.14;$ 

R = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd id the limit of MPE, 1 mW/cm2. If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

Software provided by client enabled the EUT to transmit and receive data at lowest, middle and highest channel individually.
