RESET<p>Use a pin or paper clip to reset the device.</p></div><div>3. USB<p>Connect to a USB flash drive.</p></div><div>4. Micro SD Card<p>Insert Micro SD Card(max 32GB) here.</p></div><div>5. This is done by confirming the date under "Backup frame to external storage (e.g. microSD card)". If the last backup is too old or if no backup is made, then press the "Backup frame to external storage (e.g. microSD card)" button to make a new backup. This will remove their permission to send photos to the frame. The default setting is to turn off the screen at 20:00 and to turn it back on at 08:00. This can be changed by setting your preferred sleep mode start/end time. FCC Statement
