Where

Pd = power density in mW/cm²

Pout = output power to antenna in mW

G = gain of antenna in linear scale

Pi = 3.1416

r = distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm

Pd is the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm². If we know the maximum gain of the antenna and the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance r where the MPE limit is reached.

The WLAN 2.4GHz Band can transmit simultaneously. Therefore, the Max Power Density at R (20 cm) = 0.0428mW/cm² < 1mW/cm².
