Getting Started

Powering On

 Plug the AC/DC adapter tip into the "DC In" jack located on the back and the other end to a wall outlet (110V AC). Sound Round will turn on and is ready to use.

Setting the Time

- 1. Press and hold down ⊙ button till the time flashes then RELEASE the ⊙ button. Press the +/- buttons to adjust the hour.
- 2. Tap the \odot button and the minutes will flash. Press the +/- buttons to adjust the minutes.

Battery Backup

Sound Round has an internal backup battery that you never need to replace it. When power is out

- · The alarm will still sound
- · The display will be off to save battery power
- When power is back on the clock and alarm. settings will be restored

Using the Alarm

Setting the Alarm

- 1. Press and hold down \(\begin{aligned} \text{button till the time} \end{aligned} \) flashes then RELEASE the . button. Press the +/- buttons to adjust the hour.
- 2. Tap the **\(\)** button and the minutes will flash. Press the +/- buttons to adjust the minutes.
- 3. Tap the ♠ button to set snooze time using +/buttons to select 5, 10 or 15 minutes.
- 4. Tap the ♣ button and use +/- buttons to set the alarm chime sound C1 - C6.

C1 Wake Tone 1 C4 Classic Alarm Bell C2 Wake Tone 2 C5 Wind Chimes

C3 Wake Tone 3 C6 Morning Birds

5. Tap \(\begin{aligned} \text{button and use +/- buttons to set the } \end{aligned} \) chime volume L1 lower to L5 louder.

Enable / Disable the Alarm

- · The icon will light to the left of the time display when the alarm is enabled. If the icon is not shown, the alarm is disabled and won't sound.

When the Alarm Sounds

- 1. Press the 🛈 button to snooze
- 2. Press ANY OTHER BUTTON to stop the alarm. The **\(\)** icon will stay lit and the alarm will be ready to sound again tomorrow.

Sound Machine

Listening to Sounds

- 1. Press the ♣ or ≈ button to turn the Sound Machine on and select the sound
- 2. Adjust the volume using the +/- buttons
- 3. Press the \clubsuit or \approx button to turn the speaker off (after 7 seconds when time is shown on display)

Bluetooth Speaker

Bluetooth Setup

- Press 8 to turn on Bluetooth speaker and to enter pairing mode.
- The Bluetooth \blacksquare icon on the display will flash while Sound Round is discoverable.
- Open the Bluetooth settings on your phone or other device and select Sound Round to pair.
- The next time you turn the Bluetooth speaker on it will automatically connect to your paired device when it is within range.
- To connect to a different device, press and hold the Bluetooth 3 button till the 🞵 icon on the display starts to flash. Repeat the pairing process.

Using Bluetooth

- 1. Press 13 to play or pause audio playback
- 2. Adjust the volume using the +/- buttons
- 3. Press 8 Bluetooth button to turn the speaker off

"Sound Round" will stay in pairing mode for 30 seconds to allow a phone or device to be paired and then will automatically turn off. The range for Bluetooth is approx 30ft. To disconnect a device that is connected, press and hold the Bluetooth buttons for 2 seconds.

Sleep Timer

- 1. The Sleep Timer will turn off the Sound Machine or Bluetooth speaker at the end of the time set. This can be helpful to fall asleep with sound.
- 2. Press **3** button to select the Sleep Timer duration: 1 Hour. 2 Hour. 4 Hour. 8 Hour or OFF
- 3. When Sleep Timer is active 3 icon will be lit to the left of the time display
- 4. After timer is set, you can press 2 to cancel and turn the sound off






USB Charging Port

- Charge phones, wireless earbuds, smart watches and other USB powered devices
- Plug a compatible charging cable into your device (not included) and the other end of the cable into the USB charging port on the back

______ <u>TIP</u> If the alarm is not sounding, please check:

- 1. Make sure the alarm icon **A** on the display is lit. If it's not tap the Alarm button till it lights up.
- 2. Check to make sure both the clock time and alarm time are set to correct AM/PM



Adjusting the Display Brightness

Press dimmer button to cycle through the brightness for the display

TIP The buttons light up to make them easier to use in the dark. When any button is pressed all the buttons will light for 5 seconds


Sound Machine

- Press ≈ to choose white noise options
- Press **\$** to choose nature sounds and lullabies
- · Press and hold button to turn the sounds off

Ring Light

- Press to turn on the ring light that shines around the base of Sound Round
- · Hold down to adjust the brightness

Troubleshooting

If your Sound Round is not functioning properly, it may be caused by electro-static discharge or other interference. Unplug the DC jack and remove backup batteries, plug the DC jack to the clock. Reinstall the backup batteries after 10 seconds. Sound Round will reset to default settings and you will need to set the time and alarm again.

Product Care

- 1. Place Sound Round away from areas with direct sunlight, excessive heat or moisture.
- Protect your furniture when placing Sound Round on a natural wood and lacquered finish by using a cloth or protective material between it and the furniture.
- 3. Clean Sound Round with a soft cloth moistened only with mild soap and water. Stronger agents such as Benzine, thinner or similar materials can damage the surface of the unit.
