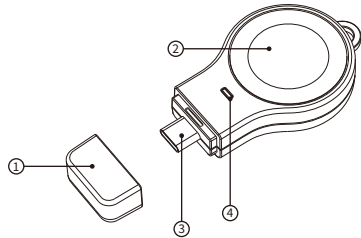


Apple Watch Charger-Product Structure



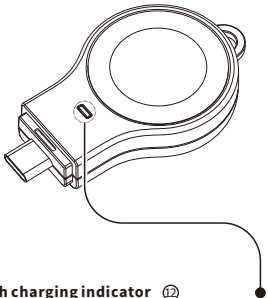
- ① Wireless Charging Area for Apple Watch ----- ★ P16

Apple Watch Charger-LED Usage



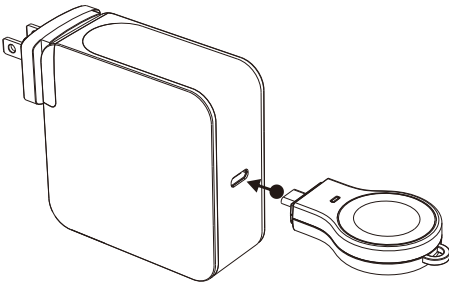
Watch charging indicator

Wireless charging for Apple Watch

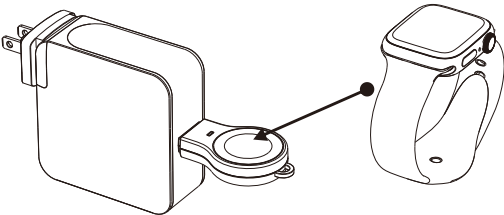
Please remove the case of watch charger and inserted it into the corresponding position of charging dock.
