MPE Prediction

<i>Frequency range (MHz)</i>	<i>Power density (mW/cm²)</i>
400 - 1500	f/1500
1500 - 100000	1 mW/cm ²

Equation for calculation

$$S = P * G / (4\pi R^2)$$

Where: S – Power density
P – Power input to antenna
G – Antenna gain relative to isotropic radiator
R – Distance to antenna

Maximum peak output power at antenna terminal: +28.9 dBm (776.24 mW)

Antenna gain: 2.77 dBi

Prediction distance: 20cm

MPE limit for General Population/Uncontrolled Exposure: 1 mW/cm²

Calculation's results:

Power density at 20cm distance: **0.2922 mW/cm²**
