



SELFIE STICK USE



With a 360° rotation, the mounting phone cradle can be used either portrait or landscape or any combination.

PORTRAIT MOUNTING



Mount your phone in the cradle by pulling the clip to the right.

LANDSCAPE MOUNTING



The clip should be pulled upward, away from you, when mounting in landscape.

NOTE: The cradle fits phones up to 3.5" (vertically). Make sure your phone's side buttons are not blocked.


SETUP OPTIONS



The selfie stick can be extended to the length you desire (up to 58") and the cradle can be tilted to your desired angle (up to 270°).

TRIPOD USE

Opening the selfie stick handle will allow you to unfold the tripod's legs.



NOTE: The tripod should be positioned on a flat surface that is stable and balanced.

BLUETOOTH PAIRING



To pair the Bluetooth remote to your phone:

- When you toggle the power switch up, it should show ON, indicating it is on. As it enters Pairing Mode, the indicator light will begin to flash.
- To connect, search for and select "Selfie" in your phone's Bluetooth menu.
- A successful pairing will result in the LED indicator turning off.


Using the Power Button, cycle through the lighting mode until the light powers off.

NOTE: Each color has 3 dimmable brightness options. To change the brightness just cycle press Power Button.


BLUETOOTH REMOTE CONTROLS
