The following additional description is provided for the Long-Term Confidentiality request for the Internal Photos Exhibit request:

- 1) Internal photos are not published in User Manuals. The user does not need to access these photos to operate the equipment properly. The Graphical User Interface is what is used to control the unit and make the proper settings for safe operation.
- 2) There are no user serviceable parts inside the unit. All service requiring disassembly of the unit requires the unit to be returned to the factory. Any user access inside the unit would void the warranty.
- 3) All sales of the device is subject to proprietary information protection by the authorized installer and the end-user.
- 4) This device is not accessible to the public. An Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) is required in order for a technician to have access to install/service the device if performed by someone other than Safe-com Wireless. A sample of the NDA is attached.
