Analysis Report

The equipment under test (EUT) is a transmitter for a R/C Light Tube Racer operating at 27.145 MHz which is controlled by a crystal. The EUT is powered by two 1.5 V AA batteries. For more detail information pls. refer to the user manual.

Antenna Type: integral antenna Antenna Gain: 0dBi Modulation Type: Pulse modulation The nominal conducted output power specified: -30.0dBm (+/- 3dB) The nominal radiated output power (e.r.p) specified: -32.15dBm (+/- 3dB)

According to the KDB 447498 D04 v01:

The worst-case peak radiated emission for the EUT is 64.7dBuV/m at 3m in the frequency 27.145MHz The EIRP = [(FS*D) 2 / 30] mW= -30.53dBm The ERP = EIRP - 2.15 = -32.68dBm which is within the production variation.

The maximun conducted output power specified is -27.0dBm = 0.00200mW The source- based time-averaging conducted output power =0.00200mW

Since the source-based time-averaging conducted output power is well below the SAR low threshold level of 1mW, so the EUT is considered to comply with SAR requirement without testing.

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
