POWER ON / OFF

Press and hold the Multifunction button to turn the headphones ON. The LED indicator will flash BLUE and RED when the headphones are turned ON.
Press and hold the button to turn the headphones OFF. The LED indicator will stop flashing when the headphones are turned OFF.

CHARGING THE HEADPHONES

Use the Micro USB cable and connect headphones to your computer or adapter device made for USB charging. A red LED indicator will turn on when the headphones are charging. The red LED light will turn off when headphones are fully charged.

PAIRING

- Make sure your phone, computer or music device is turned on and within 1 meter of each other.
- Hold down the centre multifunction ON/OFF button for about 3 seconds until Blue and Red LED light starts flashing quickly.
- Activate the Bluetooth feature on your phone or device and set it to search for Bluetooth device (discoverable).
- Select "boAt Rockerz 480" from the list of found devices.
- If necessary, enter passcode "0000" to pair and connect the headphones to your device.
- Once successfully paired, the LED light will flash Blue once every few seconds.

PLAYBACK/CONTROLS

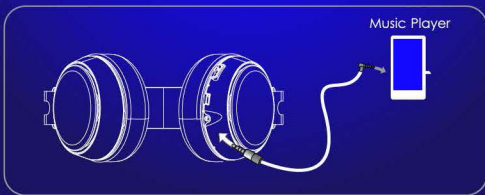
- Press multifunction button Play/Pause to start and pause audio.
 - Slide Up the Multifunction Button to skip forward to next track. Slide up and hold the Multifunction button to increase volume.
 - Slide Down the Multifunction Button to go back to the previous track. Slide Down and hold the Multifunction button to decrease volume.
- NOTE: The controls will not function when charging.

CALLS

- To answer an incoming call, press the centre multifunction button.
- To end call, press the multifunction button again.
- To Increase or Decrease volume during call, Slide up and slide down the multifunction button

USING HEADPHONES IN PASSIVE MODE (WIRED)

You can use the headphones as a wired headphone to save battery. Simply connect one end of the 3.5mm cable to your phone or device.
Note: Inserting an audio cable disables wireless functionality.



IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Listen Responsibly

To avoid hearing damage, make sure that the volume on your music player is turned down before connecting your in-ear headphones. After placing on-ear headphones on your ears, gradually turn up the volume until you reach a comfortable listening level. Noise levels are measured in decibels (dB), exposure to any noise at or above 85 dB can cause gradual hearing loss. Monitor your use; hearing loss is a function of loudness versus time. The louder it is, the less time you can be exposed to it. The softer it is, the more time you can listen to it.

Use Responsibly

Do not use Rockerz 480 when it's unsafe to do so- while operating a vehicle, crossing streets, or during any activity or in an environment where your full attention to your surroundings is required. It's dangerous to drive while wearing on-ear headphones, and in many places, illegal because it decreases your chance of hearing life-saving sounds outside of your vehicle, such as another car's horn and emergency vehicle sirens. Please avoid wearing your on-ear headphones while driving
