Limitation of Wireless WAN Data Communications


Limitation


This Notebook PC has the following limitation for Wireless WAN (Wide Area Network).

- When used in the Secondary Portrait Display Position, the primary antenna is in close proximity to the user's body (see Figure 2). Toshiba PCs are designed to meet applicable radio regulations. Therefore, as a safety precaution, wireless WAN operation will be stopped when this PC is used in the Secondary Portrait Display Position.

For above limitation, please note the following remarks:

- If the Display Position is changed to Secondary Portrait while the equipment is connecting to a base station, the Wireless WAN connection is stopped.
- If you want to use Wireless WAN, please change your PC position to any other display position and connect manually.
- If the Display position is changed to Secondary Portrait during transmitting or receiving, the data communication might not be completed. Please do not change the Display Position to Secondary Portrait during data communication.
