


### **How To Use Your Sound Stick**


- 1. Charge Sound Stick for two hours or until the four lights on the battery level indicator are on.
- 2. Press and hold the  ${\boldsymbol \theta}$  button to turn unit on. 3. The speaker will enter into Bluetooth pairing
- mode with the indicator flashing.
- 4. Find "Pinned Golf Sound" in your Bluetooth devices list and select it to pair.
- 5. Once paired and connected, you'll hear an audible confirmation from the Sound Stick and the LED indicator will stay on. Your speaker is ready to use!

## **Dual Sound Stick Pairing**

- 1. Turn on both Sound Sticks.
- 2. Press and hold the play/pause-button on one of the speakers for about 2 seconds until you hear a "beep" sound. The default is the primary speaker that you operated the Play/Pausebutton of this speaker for pairing initially.
- 3. Release play/pause button. It can take a few more seconds before speakers connect to each other. Check the indicator lights to distinguish L/R channel: The white light on one speaker is flashing white for every 3 seconds that should be the left channel (the primary speaker); the white light on the other speaker is solid white that should be the right channel.
- 4. Go into the Bluetooth menu on your phone and pair the speakers with your phone by selecting "Pinned Golf Sound" (it will only display I speaker which is both combined in to one connection).
