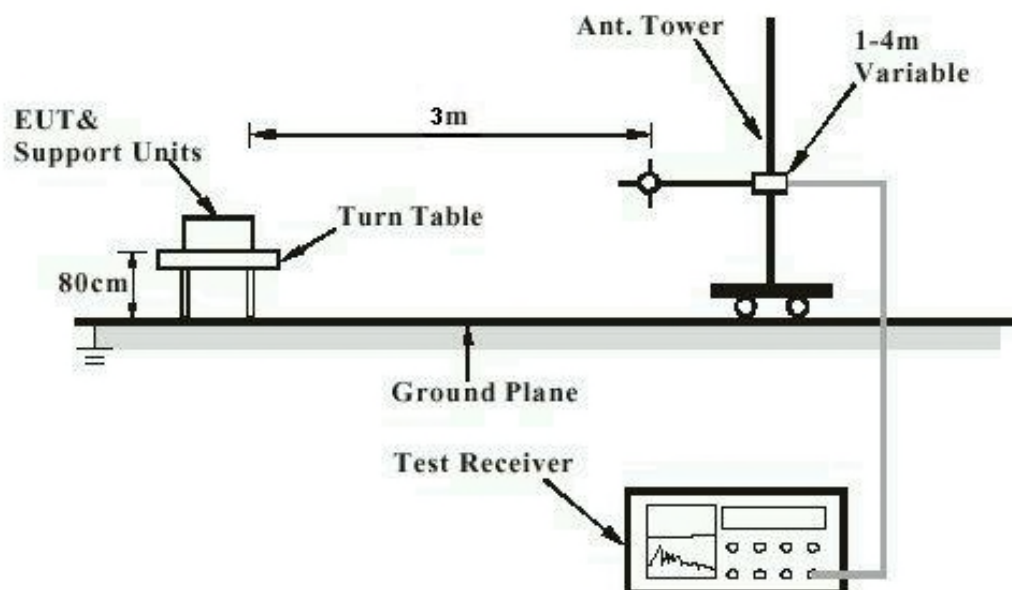

Diagram of Measurement Equipment Configuration for Mains Conduction Measurement (if applicable)

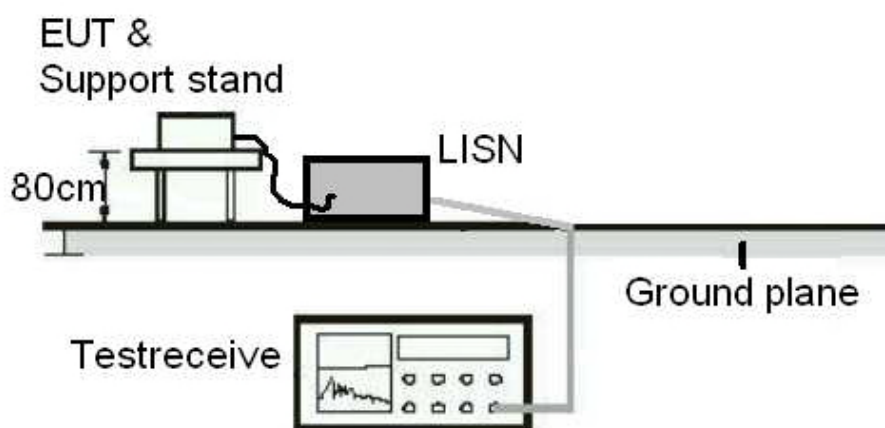
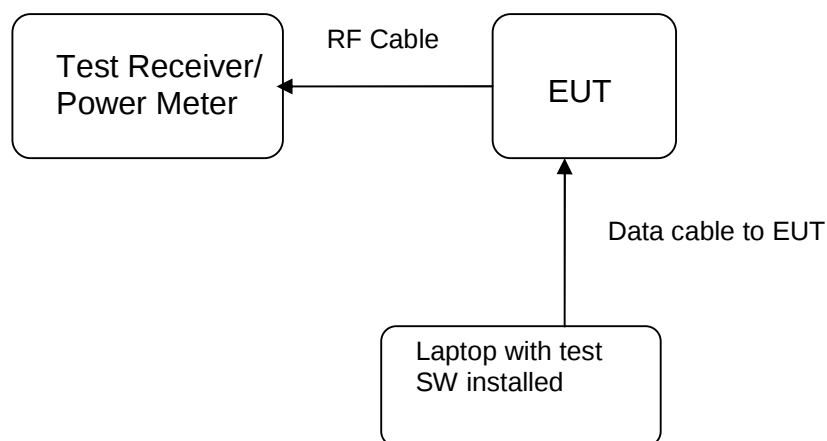


Diagram of Measurement Equipment Configuration for Conducted Transmitter Measurement

Test Plot of 6dB Bandwidth

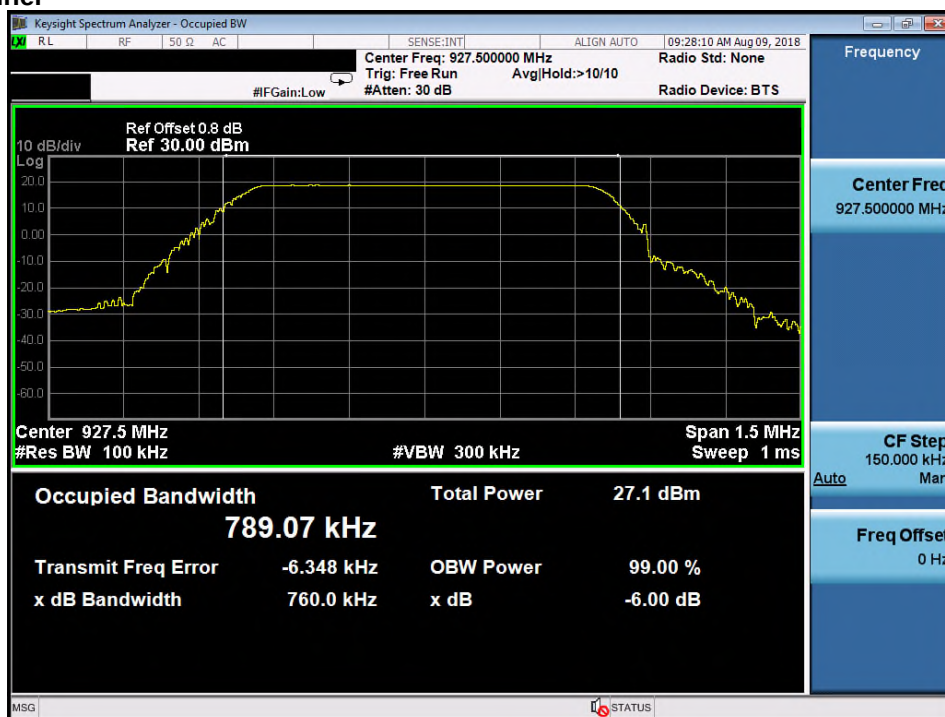

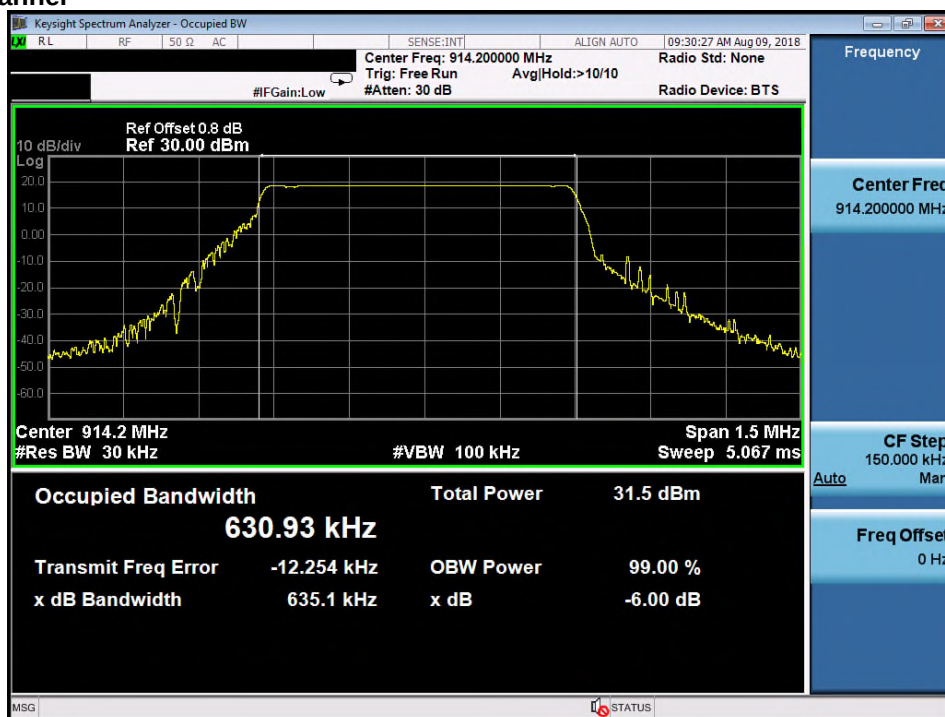


Test Plot of 99% Bandwidth

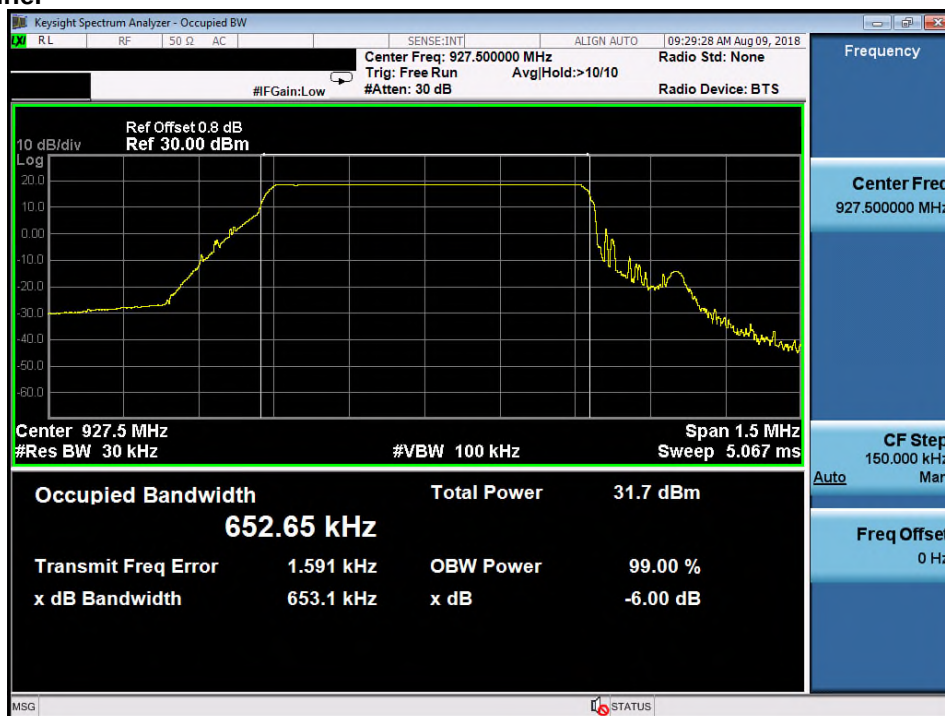

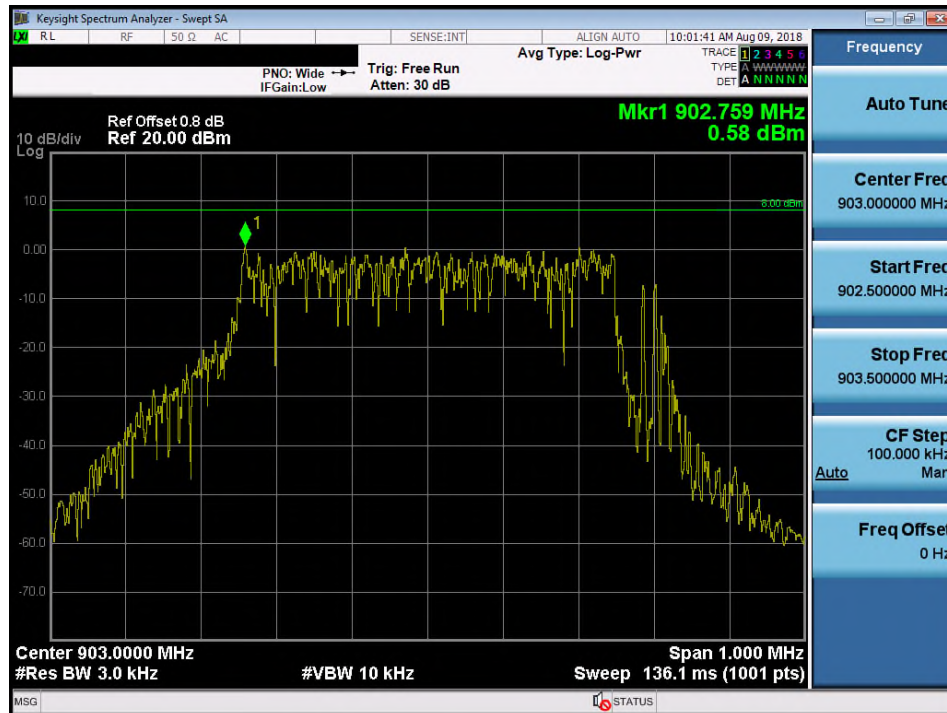

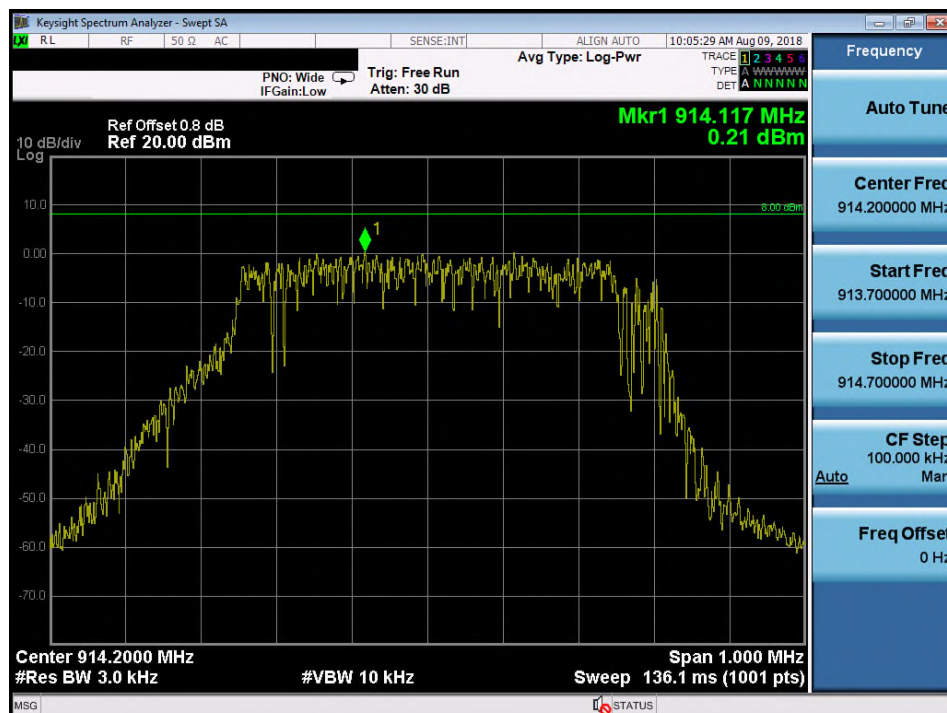

Test Plot of Power Density (500kHz Bandwidth)

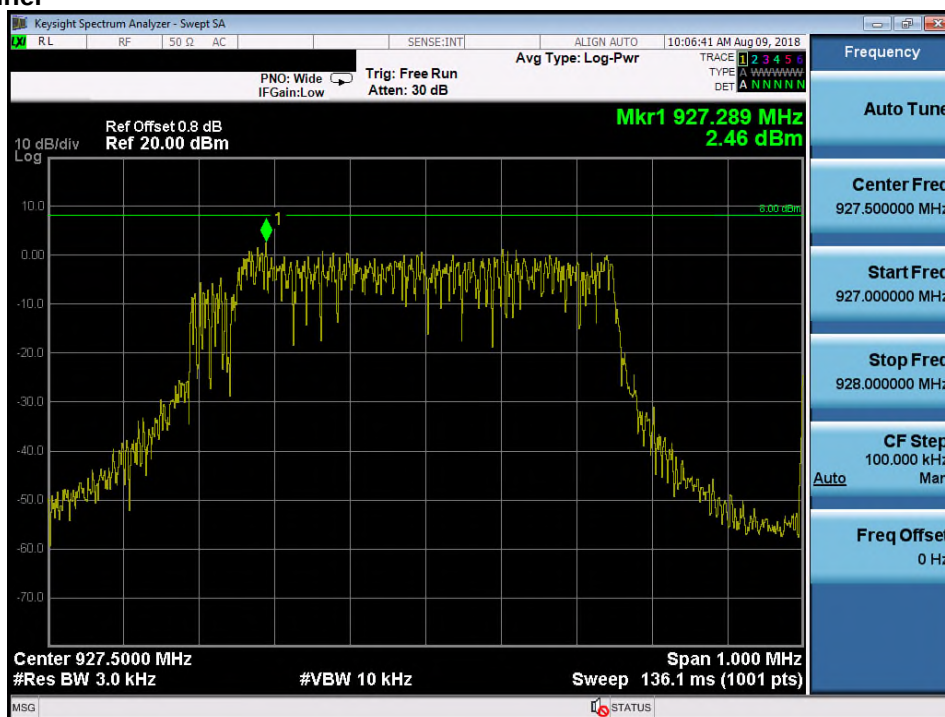

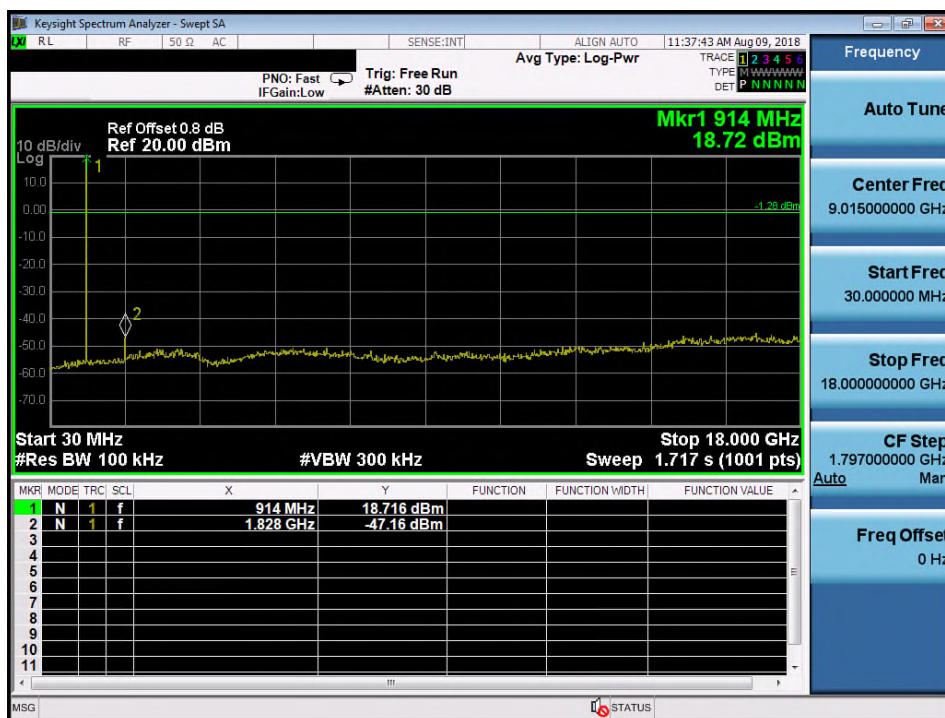

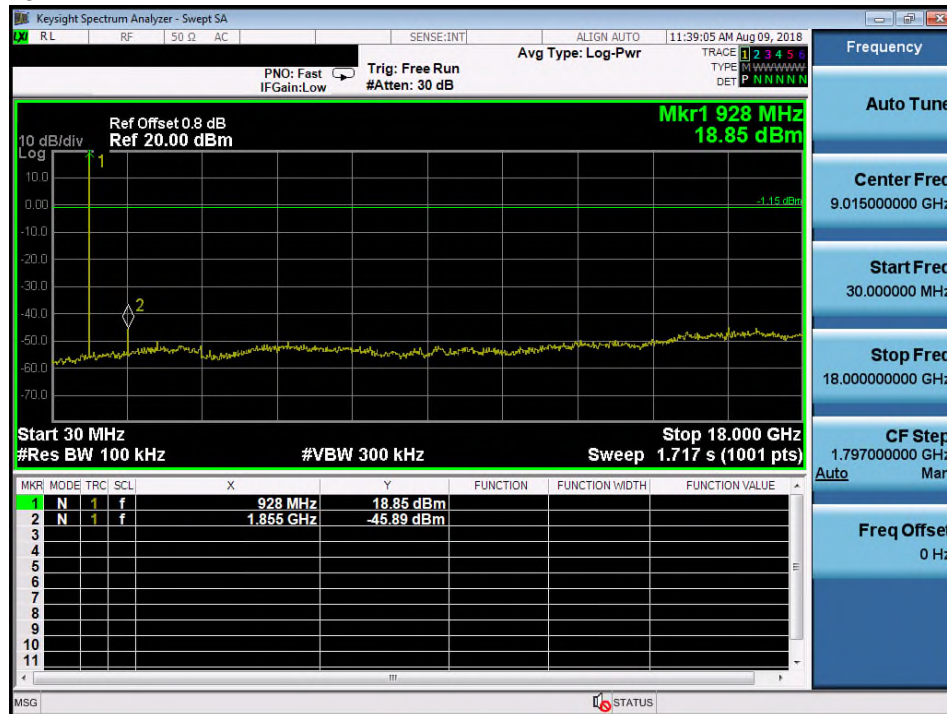
Test Plot 100kHz Conducted Emissions

Low Channel



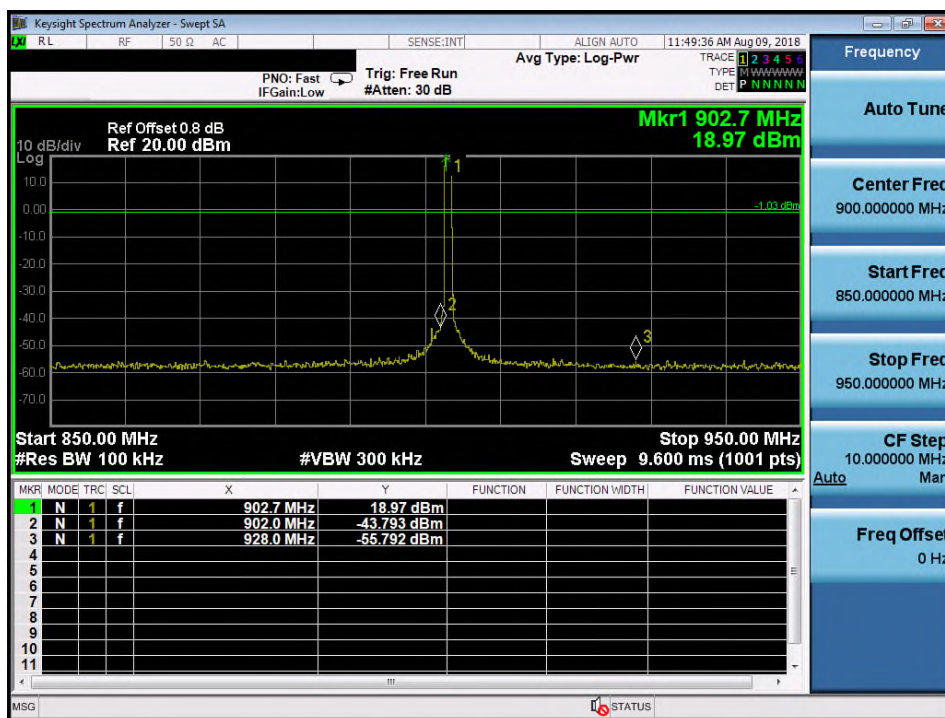
Middle Channel



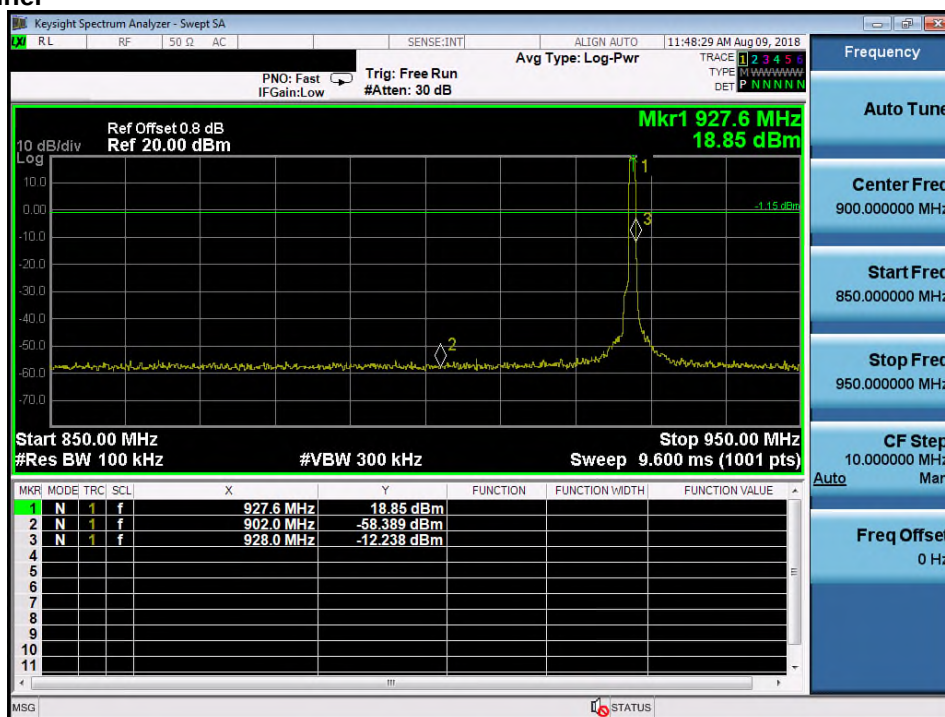
High Channel

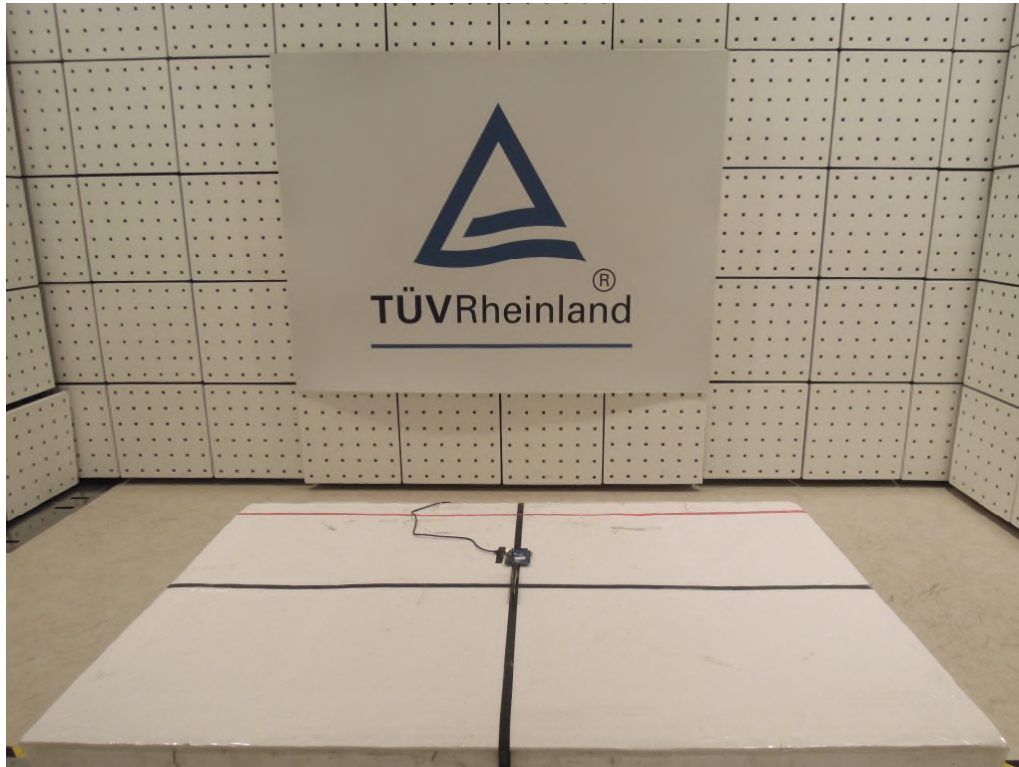

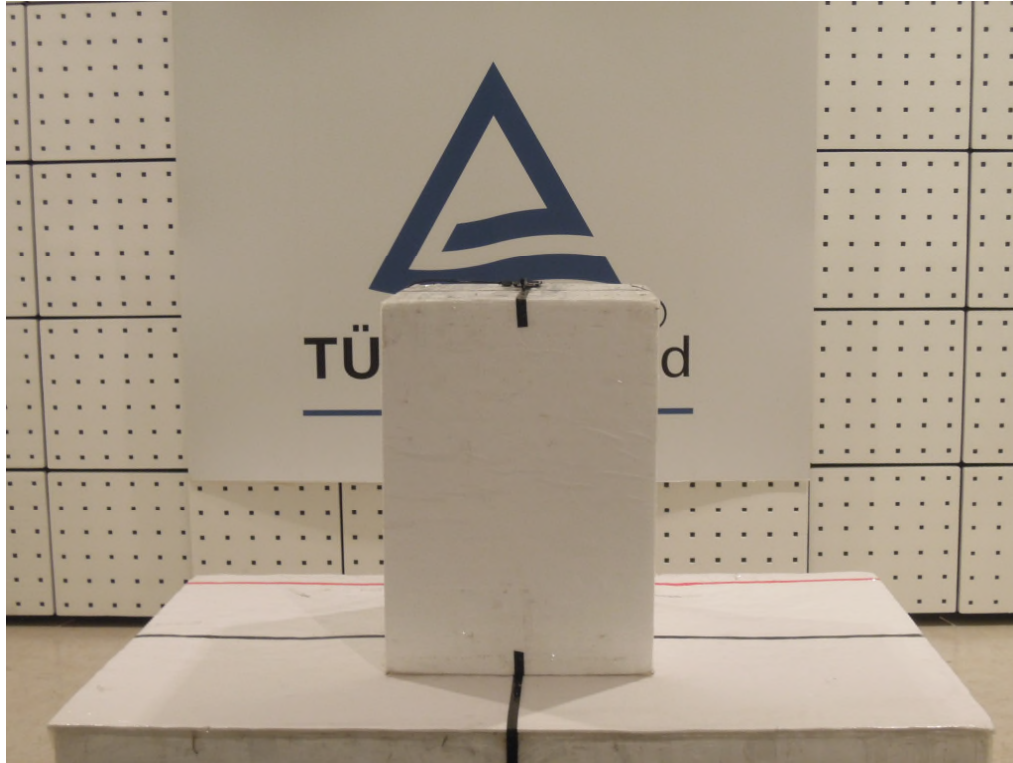

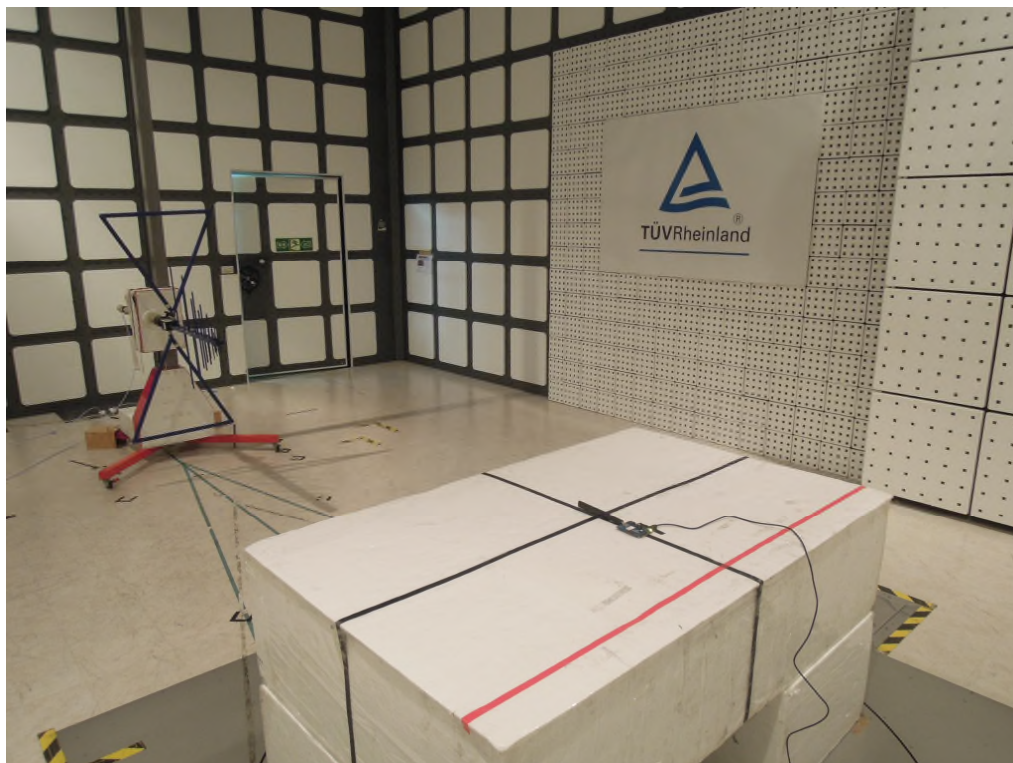
Photograph 1: Set-up for Spurious Emissions (Front View 1)



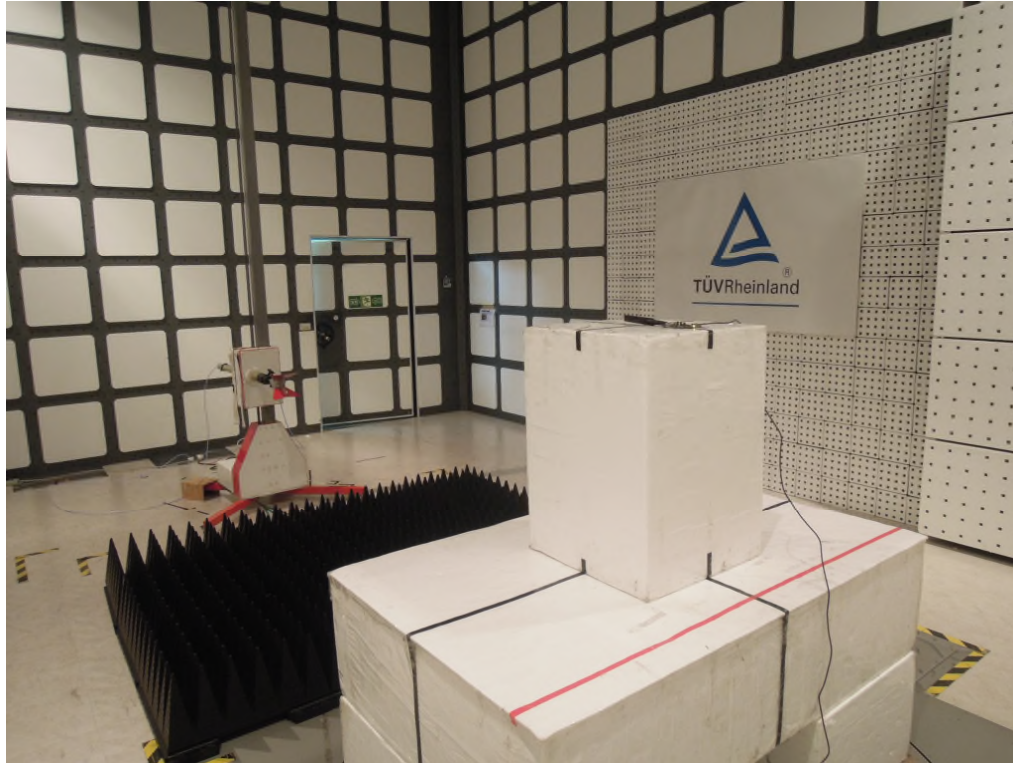
Photograph 2: Set-up for Spurious Emissions (Front View 2)



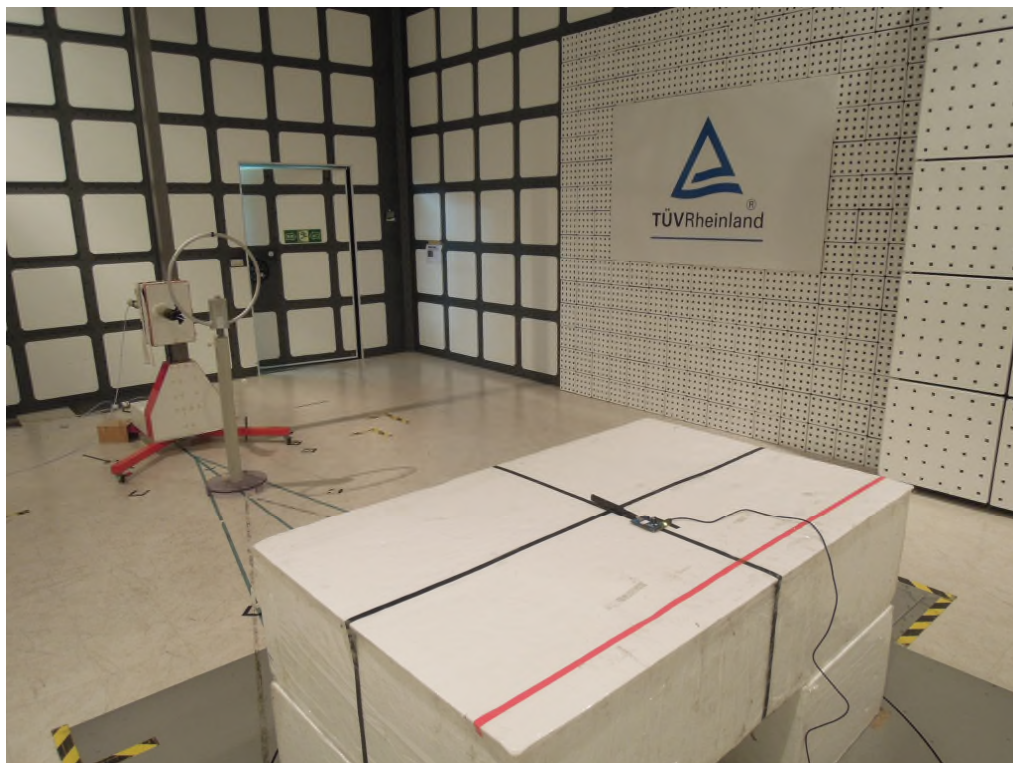

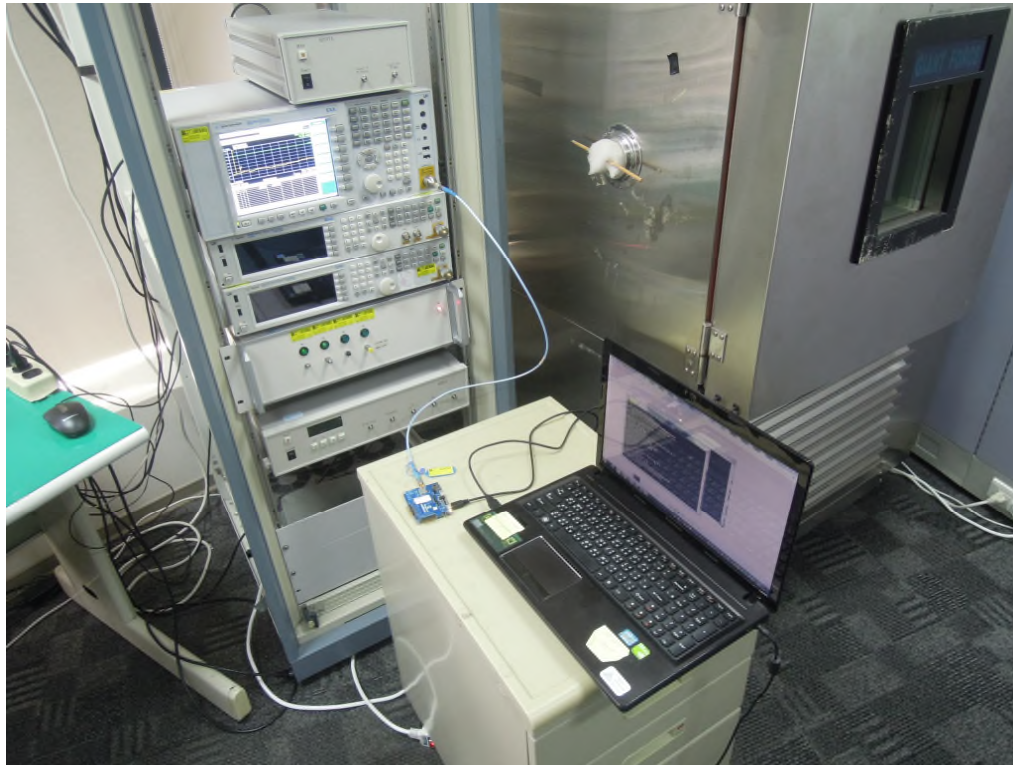

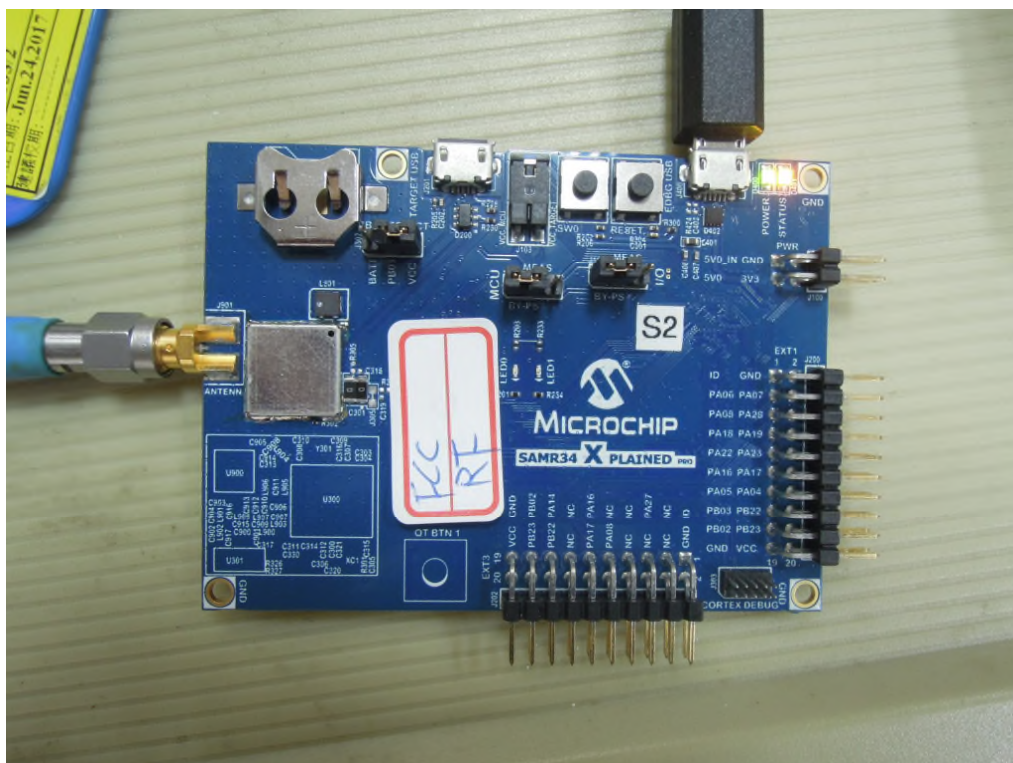

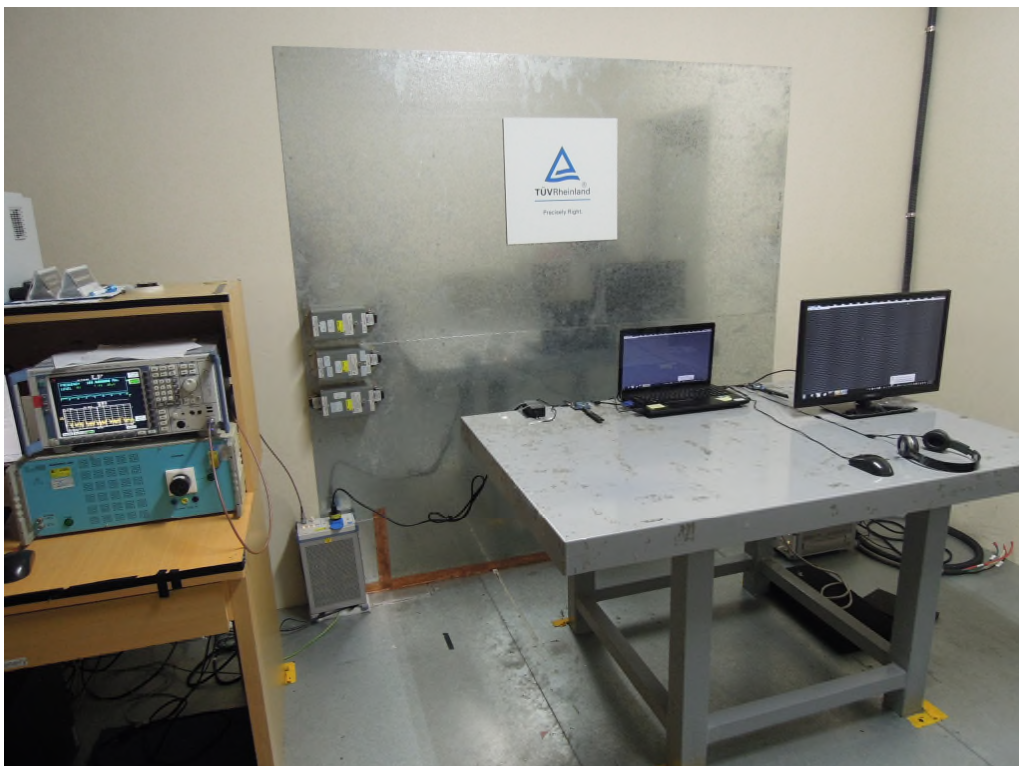
