Quick start instructions

Power On: long pressing the Power On/Off button on charging to power on the watch.

Phone Calling

This interface can control the phone's make calls, answer calls, and more.

Music Control

The watch can be used to control the music playing on the phone.

TWS Status

Instructions for using the Bluetooth headset function

A: Yes, pressing

1. Press the power button on the headset.

B: The middle surface of the headset is a touch surface, which is used to control the phone's make calls, answer calls, and more.
