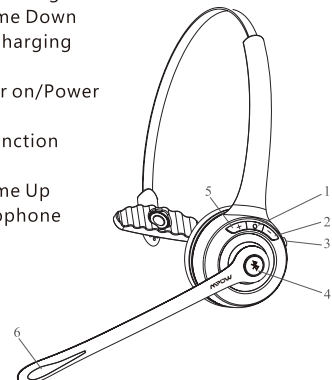




Product Diagram

Charging the Headset

You must charge the headset fully before using the headset for the first time.

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the USB charge port on the headphone.
 2. The indicator light will turn into red when charging.
 3. The full charge takes about 2 hours.
 4. The red indicator light goes out when charging completed.
- Low battery alert:
When the battery is low, the red indicator light will flash. You must charge it as soon as possible.

Power on/off the Headset

Power on:
Long press the multi-button about 4 second until the blue indicator light flashes three times.

Power off:
Long press the multi-button about 4 second until the red indicator light flashes three times and goes off .

Pair with Your Phone

1. Pair the Bluetooth headset with your device for the first time, the distance between the Bluetooth headset and your phone would be better within 1 meter.
2. With the headset power off, long press power on button about 3 second until the red and blue lights star flashing alternately
3. Open the "search for the Bluetooth devices" function on your phone.
4. Choose "Mpow".

Connect to Two Bluetooth Devices at the Same Time

1. After pair the Bluetooth headset with the first phone successfully according to the above, turn off your first phone's Bluetooth function and your Bluetooth headset.
2. Re-open the Bluetooth headset to pair with your second phone.
3. After pair successfully, turn on the Bluetooth function on the first phone and connect to the Bluetooth headset manually.

Note:

Some functions might be restricted if you connect your Bluetooth headset to two phone together.

Answering/Ending/Rejecting a Call

Answering a call:
Press the "Answer" button on your phone or short press the multi-function button on your headset.

Ending a call:
Press the "End" button on your phone or short press the multi-function button on your headset.

Rejecting a call:
Press the "End" button on your phone or long press the multi-function button on your headset.

Redialing the Last Dialed Number/ Voice Dial/Call Mute

Redialing the last dialed number:
If your phone supports this function,
double press the multi-function button
at stand-by mode.

Voice dial:
If your phone supports this function,
long press the multi-function button for
about 2 seconds at stand-by mode.

Call mute:
You can long press the "*" button when you don't want the other side to hear your words with others during a call, long press the "*" button again the other side can regain sound.

Volume Control

Volume up:
Short press "+" button, each time will
increase one volume
Volume down:
Short press "-" button, each time will
decrease one volume.
