








Clamp base

The ear groove on this side of the host




Clamp type base clamping In a suitable position on the left side of the helmet

#### Power on/off mode

Press and hold the \*\*X\*\* button for 3 seconds to turn on/off, and prompt to turn on/off.

(The power on LED light flashes quickly, and the power off LED light goes out)

# Bluetooth connectivity

Turn on the phone, turn on Bluetooth, click on search for Bluetooth devices, and find the device named X-20 Bluetooth click to connect.

## Song switching/volume up and down

Volume up and down: "+" short press to increase volume, "-" short press to decrease volume

Song switching: "+" long press a Next Song, "-" long press the previous song Pause/Play Song: Short press "%" to pause playback

#### Incoming call

\*X\* Press and hold for 2 seconds to reject the call. "X\* Short press to answer /end the call.

Double click "X" twice to call back the last contact's phone number from the most recent call.

## Automatic/manual answer switching

When a phone call is received, the number will be automatically reported, and once it is reported, it will be answered automatically.

Manually answer phone calls/automatically answer phone calls. Double click "—" to switch between

The prompt sound "beep" indicates manual answering, while the prompt sound "beep" indicates automatic answering.

## Chinese English voice switching

Double click "+" to switch between Chinese/English voice prompts.

## Connecting two phones simultaneously

First connect the Bluetooth of the first phone when turning on the headphones, then disconnect the Bluetooth and continue connecting to the second phone The Bluetooth of the phone does not need to be disconnected this time, just reonen the Bluetooth connection of the first phone.

#### Start the mobile voice AI assistant

After connecting your phone's Bluetooth, long press " ♥ " to start the phone's voice AI assistant.

## Color lights off and on

Double click the " 🗣 " button twice to turn on/off the color lighting function.

#### Work indicator light

When charging, the "+" button will turn on a red light, and it will turn off when fully charged; Past flashing when turned on, off when turned off, slow flashing when Bluetooth connection is successful, and always on when paused for playback.
