

Uncertainty of Frequency Response of E-field: ± 6.3% (k=2)



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

Uncertainty of Axial Isotropy Assessment: ± 0.5% (k=2)



# Dynamic Range f(SAR<sub>head</sub>) (TEM cell , f<sub>evel</sub>= 1900 MHz)



On some of the dipoles, small end caps are added to the dipole arms in order to improve matching when loaded according to the position as explained in the "Measurement Conditions" paragraph. The SAR data are not affected by this change. The overall dipole length is still according to the Standard.
















