1	Professional installation does not permit use of any antenna with the transmitter; the permitted types of antenna must be specified	The device must be used with the antenna supplied by VOGO. The reference of the Antenna is TLB-902 928-900LD-TNC
2	To qualify for professional installation, the applicant must explain why the hardware is not readily available to average consumer.	This equipment is a part of a full professional audio communication system. To operate an engineer must install and configure the full system. The device is link to other system via cables and/or optic fiber.
3	Marketing—Device cannot be sold via retail to the general public or by mail order; it must be sold to authorized dealers or installers only.	This device is sold to Audio professional providers, integrators or qualified distributors.
4	Filing must show that intended use is not for consumers and general public; rather device is generally for industrial/commercial use.	The device is dedicated to professional audio communications in the sport (official to official, coach to coach) and entertainment.
5	Explain what is unique, sophisticated, complex, or specialized about the equipment that REQUIRES it to be installed by a professional installer	The device is an interface with other audio systems and/or equipment. To do this, the installer must know the other equipment and be able to do the correct configuration.
6	Installation must be controlled.	Before each game, each installation is controlled. It must work during the game.
7	Installed by licensed professionals (e.g., device sold to dealer who hire installers).	In VAR (Video Assistant Referee) operation, engineers are present during the event to control the system.
8	Installation requires special training (e.g., special programming, access to keypad, field strength measurements made).	Vogo provide all the necessary information and training to install correctly the device.
