I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

- 1. Please note that the manual does not contain the 1.7cm separation distances for body worn SAR. Please provide this information in the safety portion of the manual.
- 2. Please note that the label is blurred and that ID number is not clear. Please provide a clear label.
- 3. Please note that Part 15 applications require a separate test setup photo exhibit to be provided. Please provide a separate test setup photo exhibit for the Bluetooth testing.
- 4. Please note that the probe appears to have been calibrated at 900MHz. According to the Oct 2002 TCB training sheets, probe calibration data for devices in this range should be calibrated at 835MHz, or the mid range frequency. The calibration data for this range in the SAR report in not in accordance with the FCC allowable guidelines. Please explain and please provide probe calibration data acceptable to the FCC training instructions for TCB approval.
- 5. The table on page 9 of the SAR report does not list the frequency used for validation. Please provide.
- 6. The table o page 12 of the SAR report also does not provide the frequency used in the measurement. Please provide.
