Hello,

We have referenced the FCC Document 784748 D02 V02 for Electronic Labeling Guidance. It is unclear to us whether it is allowed for a Toothbrush with a built-in Bluetooth module to use an e-label on the companion device it is paired with. The toothbrush does not have its own display. The toothbrush connects to a smart device (smartphone or tablet) via Bluetooth. The user will install an App on their device that will communicate with the toothbrush. The toothbrush transmits data (brushing time) to the phone. Please advise if this device qualifies to use an e-label. Thank you.
