

#### How to Use:


- 1. Project to the direction of the sky (on the ceiling) ideal for indoor use.
- 2. Operate as illustrated in the following figure to use the projector correctly.
- Connects to your mobile device via Bluetooth "Jurassic Projector Speaker" so you can play music on it using a Bluetooth speaker.

4. Use the remote controller correctly, ensuring that the remote controller points to the infrared sensor.

- 20. Time Setting Cancel: Short press "RESET" button to cancel the time setting, then "buzz" once as a reminder.
- 21. Main Switch:Turn the Device On/Off
